texts I suggest that instead of stretching the metaphorical potential of fiction to a highly intellectualized abstraction or playing down the interpretive claims of fiction by dramatizing its vulnerability like their Western counterpart the Taiwanese modernists create their texts on the borderline between the high and the low Self assertive as well as self denying each of them confronts his own intellectual vision with paradox and ambivalence In Ch en Ying chen this is expressed as a battle between a lyrical vision of ideological values and an instinctive self clowning in Ch i teng Sheng as a form of competition between pattern and contingency in Wang Chen ho as a celebration and abuse of the fictionality of fiction and in Wang Wen hsing an intense self parody I conclude that the sensitivity to the irrational and contradiction inherent with a resistance to didacticism constitutes the best part of the Chinese humanistic tradition which is continuously enriched with new dimensions by the contemporary Taiwanese writers
