Alberghene, Beverly Lyon Clark, 2014-04-08 Raising key questions about race class sexuality age material culture intellectual history pedagogy and gender this book explores the myriad relationships between feminist thinking and Little Women a novel that has touched many women s lives A critical introduction traces 130 years of popular and critical response and the collection presents 11 new essays two new bibliographies and reprints of six classic essays The contributors examine the history of illustrating Little Women Alcott s use of domestic architecture as codes of female self expression the tradition of utopian writing by women relationship to works by British and African American writers recent thinking about feminist pedagogy the significance of the novel for women writers and its implications from the vantage points of middle aged scholar parent and resisting male reader *An Old-Fashioned Girl* Louisa May Alcott, 2007-01-01 Alcott author of Little Women brings us the tale of Polly Milton a young girl who leaves her simple country life to live with wealthy city cousins But can plain Polly enjoy the sophisticated city without changing *The Afterlife of "Little Women"* Beverly Lyon Clark, 2014-11-27 Superb scrupulously researched a comprehensive narrative for understanding the changing reception of Little Women Gregory Eiselein coeditor of The Louisa May Alcott Encyclopedia The hit Broadway show of 1912 The lost film of 1919 Katharine Hepburn as Jo sliding down a banister in George Cukor s 1933 movie Mark English s shimmering 1967 illustrations Jo this time played by Sutton Foster belting I ll be astonishing in the 2004 Broadway musical flop These are only some of the markers of the afterlife of Little Women There s also the nineteenth century child who wrote If you do not make Laurie marry Beth I will never read another of your books as long as I live Not to mention Miss Manners a Little Women devotee who announced that the book taught her an important life lesson Although it s very nice to have two clean gloves it s even more important to have a little ink on your fingers In *The Afterlife of Little Women* Beverly Lyon Clark a leading authority on children s literature maps the reception of Louisa May Alcott s timeless novel first published in 1868 Clark divides her discussion into four historical periods The first covers the novel s publication and massive popularity in the late nineteenth century In the second era the first three decades of the twentieth century the novel becomes a nostalgic icon of the domesticity of a previous century while losing status among the literary and scholarly elite In its mid century afterlife from 1930 1960 Little Women reaches a low in terms of its critical reputation but remains a well known piece of Americana within popular culture The book concludes with a long chapter on Little Women s afterlife from the 1960s to the present a period in which the reading of the book seems to decline while scholarly attention expands dramatically and popular echoes continue to proliferate Drawing on letters and library records as well as reviews plays operas film and television adaptations spinoff novels translations Alcott biographies and illustrations Clark demonstrates how the novel resonates with both conservative

Writers of the American Renaissance Denise Knight,2003-12-30 The American literary canon has undergone revision and expansion in recent years and our notions of the 19th century renaissance have been reevaluated Mainstream anthologies have been revised to reflect the expanding literary canon yet resources for readers have remained widely scattered This book expands earlier definitions of the 19th century American Renaissance as represented by canonical

The American Discovery of the Norse Erik Ingvar Thurin, 1999 The interest of a group of American writers in the Norse Viking Age Scandinavians began to develop in the late 1830s reaching its high point at mid century and tapering off after the Civil War as the members of the group neared the end of their careers only one of the authors discussed Julia Clinton Jones joins the club at the end of the period This period defined as the original phase of the American discovery of the Norse features two essayists Emerson and Thoreau who refer to the Norse in writing on a variety of topics Fiction is represented by Melville alone American writers of fiction like Stowe and Hawthorne shun the Norse Neither the essayists nor Melville uses Norse themes as their primary subject That is reserved for the poets Lowell Whittier Taylor Longfellow and Julia Clinton Jones

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The Dime Novel in Children's Literature Vicki Anderson, 2014-10-16 With their rakish characters sensationalist plots improbable adventures and objectionable language like swell and golly dime novels in their heyday were widely considered a threat to the morals of impressionable youth Roundly criticized by church leaders and educators of the time these short quick moving pocket sized publications were also inevitably wildly popular with readers of all ages This work looks at the evolution of the dime novel and at the authors publishers illustrators and subject matter of the genre Also discussed are related types of children's literature such as story papers chapbooks broadsides serial books pulp magazines comic books and today's paperback books The author shows how these works reveal much about early American life and thought and how they reflect cultural nationalism through their ideological teachings in personal morality and ethics humanitarian reform and political thought Overall this book is a thoughtful consideration of the dime novel's contribution to the genre of children's literature Eight appendices provide a wealth of information offering an annotated bibliography of dime novels and listing series books story paper periodicals characters authors and their pseudonyms and more A reference section index and illustrations are all included

Grover, Frances Elizabeth Chutter, 1907 A volume of reading selections illustrated with famous paintings **The ^AOxford Handbook of Transcendentalism** Joel Myerson, Sandra Harbert Petrulionis, Laura Dassow Walls, 2010-04-16 The Oxford Handbook of Transcendentalism offers an eclectic comprehensive interdisciplinary approach to the immense cultural impact of the movement that encompassed literature art architecture science and politics *Boys at Home* Ken Parille, 2011-05 In this groundbreaking book Ken Parille seeks to do for nineteenth century boys what the past three decades of scholarship have done for girls show how the complexities of the fiction and educational materials written about them reflect the lives they lived While most studies of nineteenth century boyhood have focused on post Civil War male novelists Parille explores a broader archive of writings by male and female authors extending from 1830 1885 Boys at Home offers a series of arguments about five pedagogical modes play adventure corporal punishment sympathy shame and reading The first chapter demonstrates that rather than encouraging boys to escape the bonds of domesticity scenes of play in boys novels reproduce values associated with the home Chapter 2 argues that debates about corporal punishment are crucial sources for the culture s ideas about gender difference and pedagogical practice In chapter 3 The Medicine of Sympathy Parille examines the affective nature of mother daughter and mother son bonds emphasizing the special difficulties that boy nature posed for women The fourth chapter uses boys conduct literature and Louisa May Alcott s Little Women the preeminent chronicle of girlhood in the century to investigate not only Alcott s fictional representations of shame centered discipline but also pervasive cultural narratives about what it means to be a man Focusing on works by Lydia Sigourney and Francis Forrester the final chapter considers arguments about the effects that fictional historical and biographical narratives had on a boy s sense of himself and his masculinity Boys at Home is an important contribution to the emerging field of masculinity studies In addition this provocative volume brings new insight to the study of childhood women s writing and American culture Ken Parille is assistant professor of English at East Carolina University His articles have appeared in Children s Literature Tulsa Studies in Women s Literature Papers on Language and Literature and Children s Literature Association Quarterly
