Thus the creative process Hess describes is a vastly more protracted one than most Shakespeare scholars would admit to the absurd notion that the Bard would jot off the lines of a work in a few days or weeks and then immediately have it performed on the public stage or published shortly thereafter. Still dominates orthodox dating systems for the canon. Hess draws on the works of many other scholars for using topical allusions within each work in order to set practical limits for when the origination and subsequent alterations of each play occurred.
