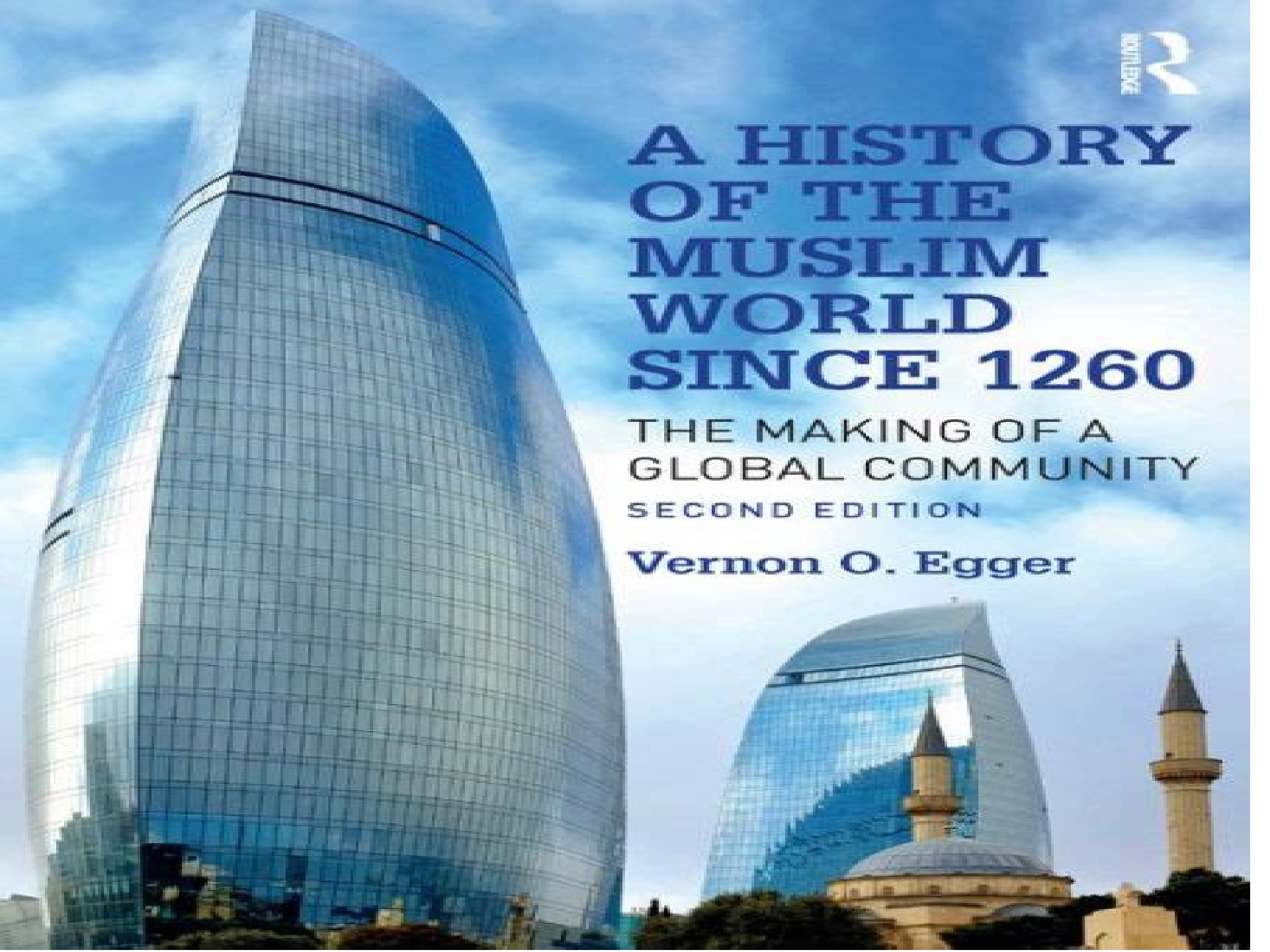

full translation with critical introduction recovers his voice It offers insight into the dawn of modern diplomacy and its overlap with literature it looks at eighteenth century Europe through Arab eyes and it explores the deep nostalgia that the Islamic past of Andalusia provoked for a Moroccan traveler who traced his family ties to exiles of the region Finally al Ghazzal s visit has further significance as the neglected backdrop to one of Spain s most canonical eighteenth century works the Moroccan Letters of Jos Cadalso Thus the world literature approach of the present introduction also reimagines the pluralism of Cadalso s foreign gaze through the encounters of the actual ambassador in his own words
