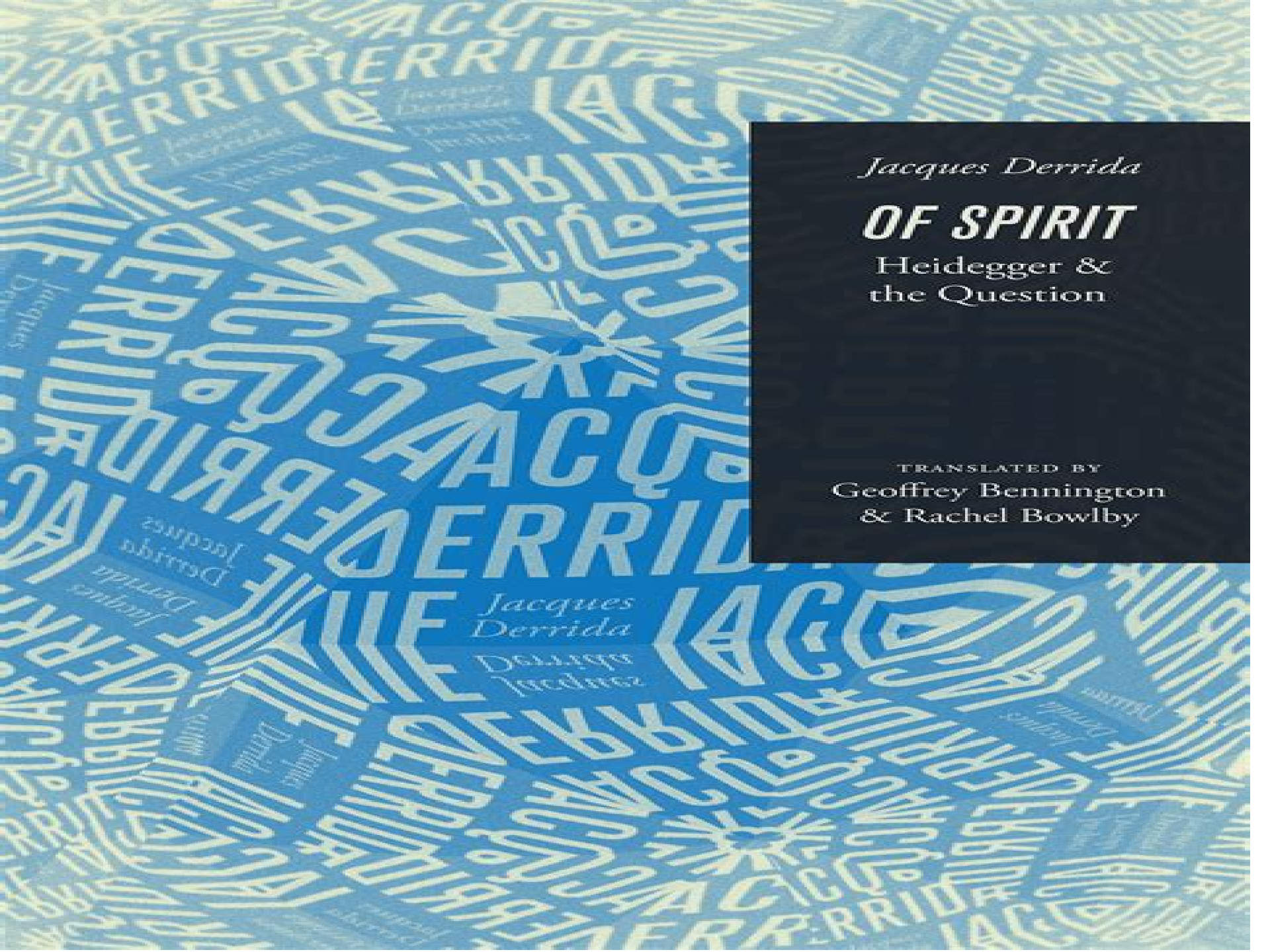

and Time that is of extraordinary value to readers of Heidegger or anyone interested in modern philosophy Derrida performs an almost surgical reading of the notoriously difficult text marrying pedagogical clarity with patient rigor and acting as a lucid guide through the thickets of Heidegger's prose At this time in intellectual history Heidegger was still somewhat unfamiliar to French readers and Being and Time had only been partially translated into French Here Derrida mostly uses his own translations giving his own reading of Heidegger that directly challenges the French existential reception initiated earlier by Sartre He focuses especially on Heidegger's Destruktion which Derrida would translate both into solicitation and deconstruction of the history of ontology and indeed of ontology as such concentrating on passages that call for a rethinking of the place of history in the question of being and developing a radical account of the place of metaphoricity in Heidegger's thinking This is a rare window onto Derrida's formative years and in it we can already see the philosopher we've come to recognize one characterized by a bravura of exegesis and an inventiveness of thought that are particularly and singularly his

The Darkening Spirit David Tacey, 2013-06-26 The twenty first century could well be Jung's century just as the twentieth century was Freud's Jung predicted the demise of secular humanism and claimed we would search for alternatives to science atheism and reason We would experience a new and even unfashionable appetite for the sacred Educated people however would not return to unreconstructed religions because these do not express the life of the spirit as discerned by modern consciousness The sacred has developed a darker hue and worshipping symbols of light and goodness no longer satisfies the longings of the soul The new sacred cannot be contained by the formulas of the past but nor can we live without a sense of

the sacred We stand in a difficult place between traditional religions we have outgrown and a pervasive materialism we can no longer embrace These changes in our culture have come sooner than Jung might have imagined In his time Jung struck many as eccentric or unscientific But his works speak to our time since we have experienced the full gamut of Jungian transformations the unsettling of Judeo Christian culture the rise of the feminine the onslaught of the dark side the critique of modernism and positivism and the recognition that the Western ego is neither the pinnacle of evolution nor the lord of creation A new life is needed beyond the ego but we do not yet know what it will look like The outbreak of strong religion and terrorism are signs of the times but these are expressions of a distorted and repressed spirit and not one hopes genuine pointers to the future What the future holds is uncertain but Jung's prophetic vision helps to prepare us for what is to come and this will be of great interest to analytical psychologists and psychoanalysts as well as to theologians futurists sociologists and the general reader

Emergence of Post-modernity at the Intersection of Liberalism, Capitalism, and Secularism Matthew McManus, 2022-09-07

This book is a systematic and thorough analysis of what post modernity is and how it emerged. It distinguishes between those who regard post modernity as a theoretical approach and those who regard it as a culture and argues that interpreting post modernity as a culture is more fruitful. It discusses the three factors which led to its emergence namely liberalism capitalism and secularism highlighting their respective influence in generating the culture of post modernity within neoliberal societies. The volume provides a lengthy analysis of neoliberal post modernity in practice arguing that post modernism is the cultural condition of neoliberal societies in the late 20th and early 21st centuries. Until recently it seemed that neoliberal post modernity was here to stay framed by relationship to freedom and time which stressed individual agency but precluded the possibility of historical change at the political level. However the Great Recession of 2008 opened new spaces for agitation and transformation which has resulted in the discordant politics of the last decade. This book will be of interest to scholars working in a number of fields including economic policy cultural analysis political theory and social critique.
