Ott, 1987-07 On the night of August 22 1791 thousands of small illuminated specks could be seen on the otherwise darkened Plaine du Nord of Saint Domingue in the Caribbean With a torch in one hand and a knife in the other the slave of Saint Domingue was destroying a society which had suppressed him for nearly one hundred years But the agonies of that night were only the beginning of a great socioeconomic explosion lasting almost thirteen years During that period Saint Domingue emerged as Haiti the first Black republic in the Western Hemisphere Although the American French Russian and Mexican revolutions have received the attention of many scholars the Haitian Revolution has remained in relative obscurity Even those historians who have made a study of that turmoil often viewed much of it ideologically In *The Haitian Revolution* Thomas O Ott provides a long needed objective synthesis of the events and ideas which shaped this heroic period In doing so he has contributed significant new details and persuasive interpretations The background of the Haitian Revolution was one of dreams and lost hopes the substance of other great upheavals Against this background Professor Ott identifies and throws light upon a number of themes the influence of the French Revolution the abolition of slavery the fear of revolt among other slave societies the intervention of foreign powers and the rise of a Black republic Yet he makes evident the major theme of the period was not an event but a man Toussaint L Ouverture Leaving a rather idyllic environment at Breda Plantation on the Plaine du Nord Toussaint joined the rebels and rose from obscurity to prominence within an astonishingly short timespan With the dexterity of a tightrope walker and the finesse of a fencer Toussaint had outplayed all but one of his rivals for power by mid 1800 That one who remained however was Napoleon Bonaparte In the final contest between these two men Toussaint dying a tragic death in a dank French prison would see his vision of Haitian independence near oblivion But the fading dream was rescued by Jean Jacques Dessalines Toussaint's fierce lieutenant and by the Haitian people themselves To achieve objectivity Professor Ott has gone beyond the sources traditionally consulted He has utilized numerous newspaper accounts mainly written by observant Yankee seamen and has also investigated the American consul reports of the period But the many French references such as the heretofore untapped papers of Donatien Rochambeau have not been neglected

For over three centuries enslavement promoted the rise of capitalism in the Atlantic world. The New World became the crucible for a succession of fateful experiments in colonization: silver mining, plantation agriculture, racial enslavement, colonial rebellion, slave witness and slave resistance. Slave produce raised up empires, fostered new cultures of consumption and financed the breakthrough to an industrial order. Not until the stirrings of a revolutionary age in the 1780s was there the first public challenge to the peculiar institution. An anti-slavery alliance then set the scene for great acts of emancipation in Haiti in 1804, Britain in 1833, the United States in the 1860s and Cuba and Brazil in the 1880s. Toussaint Louverture and the American Civil War Matthew J. Clavin, 2010. At the end of the eighteenth century a massive slave revolt rocked French Saint Domingue, the most profitable European colony in the Americas. Under the leadership of the charismatic former slave François Dominique Toussaint Louverture a disciplined and determined republican army consisting almost entirely of rebel slaves defeated all of its rivals and restored peace to the embattled territory. The slave uprising that we now refer to as the Haitian Revolution concluded on January 1, 1804 with the establishment of Haiti, the first black republic in the Western Hemisphere. The Haitian Revolution cast a long shadow over the Atlantic world. In the United States according to Matthew J. Clavin there emerged two competing narratives that vied for the revolution's legacy. One emphasized vengeful African slaves committing unspeakable

acts of violence against white men women and children The other was the story of an enslaved people who under the leadership of Louverture vanquished their oppressors in an effort to eradicate slavery and build a new nation Toussaint Louverture and the American Civil War examines the significance of these competing narratives in American society on the eve of and during the Civil War Clavin argues that at the height of the longstanding conflict between North and South Louverture and the Haitian Revolution were resonant polarizing symbols which antislavery and proslavery groups exploited both to provoke a violent confrontation and to determine the fate of slavery in the United States In public orations and printed texts African Americans and their white allies insisted that the Civil War was a second Haitian Revolution a bloody conflict in which thousands of armed bondmen American Toussaints would redeem the republic by securing the abolition of slavery and proving the equality of the black race Southern secessionists and northern anti abolitionists responded by launching a cultural counterrevolution to prevent a second Haitian Revolution from taking place
