La historiografía de la arquitectura moderna Panayotis Tournikiotis, 2001 Este libro habla de otros libros. Concretamente se estudian en él las nueve historias de la arquitectura moderna que el autor considera más representativas en su intento por explicar el movimiento arquitectónico más característico del siglo XX. El autor sostiene que la historia de la arquitectura moderna suele estar escrita desde el presente proyectando hacia el pasado nuestras preocupaciones actuales de modo que el inicio del relato actúa realmente como una representación de su final. En este libro los edificios son las citas mientras que los textos forman la estructura. La investigación se centra en un grupo de libros escritos por los principales historiadores del siglo XX: Nikolaus Pevsner, Emil Kaufmann, Sigfried Giedion, Bruno Zevi, Leonardo Benevolo, Henry Russell Hitchcock, Reyner Banham, Peter Collins y Manfredo Tafuri. Para examinar el pensamiento de estos estudiosos, el autor recurre a conceptos de la teoría crítica relacionando a la arquitectura con modelos históricos más amplios. Por otro lado, esta edición ofrece una magnífica oportunidad para revisar la validez de las versiones castellanas de los nueve textos que se estudian en el libro de los que sólo uno carece de traducción.

Los principios de la arquitectura moderna Christian Norberg-Schulz, 2019-02-15 Este libro tiene como propósito fundamental explicar en qué consiste la arquitectura moderna. Esto podría parecer bastante pretencioso, pero actualmente circulan tantos malentendidos que aportar cierta claridad se ha convertido en una necesidad urgente. Por razones de justicia es preciso recordar lo que realmente quería el Movimiento Moderno y poner de manifiesto lo que efectivamente consiguió. Algunos autores sostienen que el Movimiento Moderno es una mistificación que en realidad los arquitectos modernos no tenían ninguna ideología en común y que por tanto la arquitectura moderna no existe. Sin ninguna duda, el Movimiento Moderno tenía un fundamento y una orientación y sólo cuando se comprenda esto podremos hacer una evaluación justa de sus resultados. Incluidos los empeños posmodernos, de este modo encontraremos un punto de partida para continuar la búsqueda de una arquitectura democrática para nuestra época.

Rastrear la genealogía de la idea moderna de forma a lo largo de la estética del siglo XIX y analizar el proceso de su desarrollo en la arquitectura del siglo XX es el propósito del programa de doctorado que Helio Piñón dirige en la Escuela Técnica Superior de Arquitectura de Barcelona (ETSAB). El autor analiza la evolución de la arquitectura moderna desde el Art Nouveau surgido en la última

d cada del siglo XIX hasta las aportaciones de Louis Kahn realizadas a partir de mediados de los años 1960 El estudio analiza las complejas motivaciones que impulsaron ese Movimiento Moderno considerado revolucionario y da cuenta de sus éxitos y sus fracasos Se repasa también la actividad de los principales protagonistas del periodo como Frank Lloyd Wright Adolf Loos Ludwig Mies van der Rohe Le Corbusier y Alvar Aalto y se ofrece una nueva visión de su papel como maestros de reconocido prestigio Alan Colquhoun explica que la línea que ha seguido en la definición de la arquitectura moderna es la que pertenece a la tradición que la consideraba una arquitectura consciente de su propia modernidad que luchaba en favor del cambio El libro trata de situarse en el espacio que queda entre las utopías idealistas de las vanguardias históricas y las resistencias complejidades y pluralidades de la cultura capitalista La exposición sigue una secuencia cronológica global e intenta ser segura en el autor menos segura en su resultado y menos triunfalista que la mayoría de las historias anteriores del Movimiento Moderno Sigue siendo principalmente una historia de los maestros debido a que esa era la naturaleza del propio Movimiento Moderno pese a sus muchas reivindicaciones en favor del anonimato Esta edición española incluye un prólogo de Joaquín Medina Warmburg catedrático de Historia de la Arquitectura en la Universidad Politécnica de Karlsruhe

Pero esta conexión no solo fue en un sentido ya que si Mil influyó en Barcelona también Barcelona influyó en Mil y no únicamente en términos urbanos y arquitectónicos sino también políticos, económicos y sociales.
