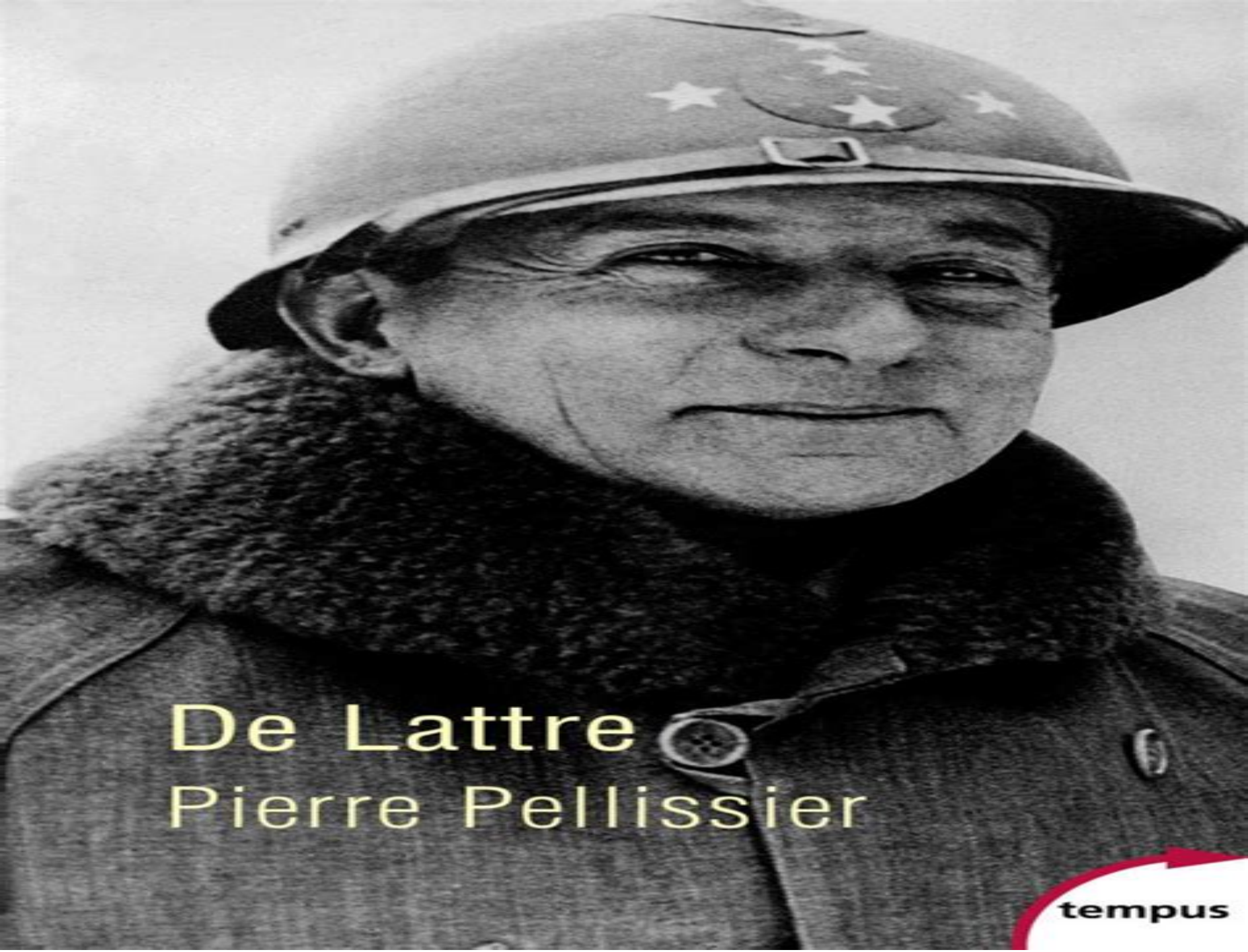

Helicopter Heroine Charles Morgan Evans, 2023-01-01 Val rie Andr is one of the great military aviators of the twentieth century She was the first woman to fly a helicopter in combat and one of the first three helicopter medevac pilots Flying more than 150 helicopter rescue missions during the French war in Indochina including at Dien Bien Phu and parachuting into the field twice Andr was a trailblazer a pioneer of flying helicopters in combat and an innovator of battlefield medicine who risked her life to treat the

wounded whether they were French or Vietnamese whether they were friend civilian or foe Aviation historian Charles Morgan Evans tells her story with verve and pathos Andr was born in Strasbourg France in 1922 From an early age she wanted to fly but as a woman she faced challenges While boys could receive government funded flight lessons Andr had to pay for hers by tutoring During World War II she left Strasbourg against German prohibitions in order to study medicine in Paris where she completed her studies under threat of arrest by the Gestapo Assigned to an army hospital in Saigon in French Indochina in the late 1940s Andr trained as a neurosurgeon performing one hundred procedures per month When the French medical corps developed mobile surgical units to be air dropped into military outposts she quickly volunteered and then when the service acquired a few primitive helicopters she volunteered for that which meant learning to fly helicopters in combat Flying through bullets and bombs fatigue parasitic illness and mechanical issues with the helicopters not to mention the French army s prejudice against a female pilot and surgeon Andr nonetheless became a legend in Indochina The Vietnamese called her the woman who comes down from the sky and Mrs Ventilator On one day in December 1951 she flew her chopper into the teeth of antiaircraft fire to a besieged base where she performed emergency brain surgeries then flew the wounded to hospitals in Hanoi two at a time After Indochina she continued to be an innovator in military aviation and medicine as well as an advocate for women s integration into the French military In the early 1960s she flew another 236 missions in Algeria In 1975 she became the first female general in the French army and at her retirement she had flown nearly 500 combat missions logged 4 000 hours in helicopters and won the Croix de Guerre five times the Cross of Military Valor twice and the Grand Cross of the National Order of Merit Andr who just turned ninety nine is still alive and lives near Paris and this book is based on a series of author interviews with her and comprehensive research in other sources **Par les portes du Nord** François de Linares,2005 **Les chantiers de jeunesse** Olivier Faron,2011-11-02 De la d faite militaire fran aise nait l institution particuli re des chantiers de jeunesse Pendant l t 1940 ils sont cr s pour tous les jeunes hommes de 20 ans r sidant en zone Sud et ils fonctionnent jusqu l t 1944 sur le territoire national et jusqu en 1945 outre Rhin o ils existent depuis 1943 Les chantiers concerneront au total plus de 400 000 jeunes n s entre 1920 et 1924 L objectif majeur est de remplacer le service militaire d sormais interdit par une exp rience diversifi e associant ducation transmission des valeurs nationales activit laborieuse vie de groupe Tout cela dans des montagnes recul es ou en pleine for t Beaucoup de r gions ont t marqu es par les chantiers de l Ain la Corr ze sans oublier des villes telles que Lyon ou Clermont Ferrand Les acteurs Jacques Charron ou Yves Montand les ministres Olivier Guichard ou Charles Hernu des patrons comme Antoine Riboud ou des artistes tels que Jean Pierre Rampal les ont connus et en ont parl comme les associations d anciens vis e corporatiste D innombrables familles fran aises en conservent le souvenir Ce livre est la premi re tude exhaustive des chantiers de jeunesse permise par des documents exceptionnels L id e des chantiers est ancienne travers ses racines scoutes et internationales caract ristiques des ann es 1930 Vichy relaie ce projet en l amplifiant puis en le d tournant au service de l

fut d'apprendre la veille de sa mort le 11 janvier 1952 qu'il était le seul à avoir la dignité de Maréchal de France. Maréchal le roi Jean comme on l'appelait par admiration mais le parfois d'agacement était de toute origine. Saint-Cyrien de la promotion précédant celle de Charles de Gaulle et Alphonse Juin deux hommes avec lesquels il entretiendra des rapports compliqués. Jean de Lattre est de tous les combats de la première moitié du XXe siècle. Le lieutenant de cavalerie qui chargeait l'ennemi la lance en 1914 achève prématurément comme commandant en chef et haut commissaire en Indochine une carrière riche et tumultueuse. Les vichysto-résistants, de 1940 à nos jours Bénédicte Vergez-Chaignon, 2008 Mitterrand a un passé Les révélations sur les attaches du président de la République avec Vichy ont fait valoir une décennie l'effet d'une bombe. Perplexes ou choqués les Français se sont demandé comment on pouvait prétendre avoir tant fait de résistant et partisan de Pétain. Le livre de Bénédicte Vergez-Chaignon est la première étude d'ensemble sur ce qui a constitué pendant cinquante ans un tabou. Grâce de multiples archives ouvertes depuis peu l'auteur dresse un panorama complet de cette résistance au profil très particulier puisqu'elle est née en 1940 autour du thème de la revanche militaire et pas de la résistance. Au fil des perceptions idéologiques et des rapprochements tactiques on voit notamment défiler le maréchal de Lattre Marie Madeleine Fourcade Pierre Bnouville Henri Frenay André Bettencourt Maurice Clavel Français Mitterrand et beaucoup d'autres aujourd'hui moins connus. Ressurgit une noblesse qui a voulu concilier combat contre l'ennemi allemand et redressement national prôné par Pétain. Or dès 1945 ce phénomène a été consciencieusement gommé jusqu'à devenir presque impossible d'imaginer. En étudiant la manière dont s'est figée l'image d'une Résistance mythifiée Bénédicte Vergez-Chaignon montre comment les vichysto-résistants se sont insérés dans la France d'après guerre et comment les clivages ont voulu après les procès de l'épuration la guerre d'Algérie et les affaires Bousquet ou Papon. Richesse des sources sûres de l'analyse et précieuses multiples font de cette somme un ouvrage indispensable pour qui s'intéresse à la Seconde Guerre mondiale et ses suites.
