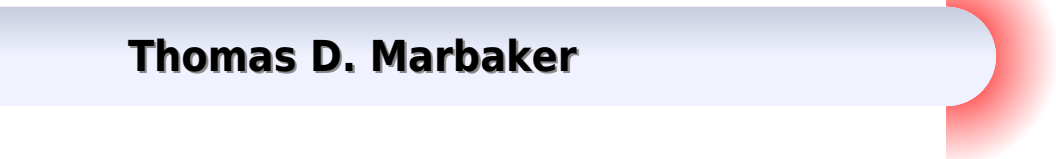

Wilson Greene, 2018-04-17 Grinding bloody and ultimately decisive the Petersburg Campaign was the Civil War's longest and among its most complex Ulysses S Grant and Robert E Lee squared off for more than nine months in their struggle for Petersburg the key to the Confederate capital at Richmond Featuring some of the war's most notorious battles the campaign played out against a backdrop of political drama and crucial fighting elsewhere with massive costs for soldiers and civilians alike After failing to bull his way into Petersburg Grant concentrated on isolating the city from its communications with the rest of the surviving Confederacy stretching Lee's defenses to the breaking point When Lee's desperate breakout attempt failed in March 1865 Grant launched his final offensives that forced the Confederates to abandon the city on April 2 1865 A week later Lee surrendered at Appomattox Court House Here A Wilson Greene opens his sweeping new three volume history of the Petersburg Campaign taking readers from Grant's crossing of the James in mid June 1864 to the fateful Battle of the Crater on July 30 Full of fresh insights drawn from military political and social history *A Campaign of Giants* is destined to be the definitive account of the campaign With new perspectives on operational and tactical choices by commanders the experiences of common soldiers and civilians and the significant role of the United States Colored Troops in the fighting this book offers essential reading for all those interested in the history of the Civil War [The Battle of Petersburg, June 15-18, 1864](#) Sean Michael Chick, 2015-06-15 The Battle of Petersburg was the culmination of the Virginia Overland campaign which pitted the Army of the Potomac led by Ulysses S Grant and George Gordon Meade against Robert E Lee's Army of Northern Virginia In spite of having outmaneuvered Lee after three days of battle in which the Confederates at Petersburg were severely outnumbered Union forces failed to take the city and their final futile attack on the fourth day only added to already staggering casualties By holding Petersburg against great odds the Confederacy arguably won its last great strategic victory of the Civil War In *The Battle of Petersburg June 15 18 1864* Sean Michael Chick takes an in depth look at an important battle often overlooked by historians and offers a new perspective on why the Army of the Potomac's leadership from Grant down to his corps commanders could not win a battle in which they held colossal advantages He also discusses the battle's wider context including politics memory and battlefield preservation Highlights include the role played by African American soldiers on the first day and a detailed retelling of the famed attack of the First Maine Heavy Artillery which lost more men than any other Civil War regiment in a single battle In addition the book has a fresh and nuanced interpretation of the generalships of Grant Meade Lee P G T Beauregard and William Farrar Smith during this critical battle **A Republic in the Ranks** Zachery A. Fry, 2020-02-21 The Army of the Potomac was a hotbed of political activity during the Civil War As a source of dissent widely understood as a frustration for Abraham Lincoln its onetime commander George B McClellan even secured the Democratic nomination for president in 1864 But in this comprehensive reassessment of the army's politics Zachery A Fry argues that the war was an intense political

education for its common soldiers Fry examines several key crisis points to show how enlisted men developed political awareness that went beyond personal loyalties By studying the struggle between Republicans and Democrats for political allegiance among the army's rank and file Fry reveals how captains majors and colonels spurred a pro Republican political awakening among the enlisted men culminating in the army's resounding Republican voice in state and national elections in 1864 For decades historians have been content to view the Army of the Potomac primarily through the prism of its general officer corps portraying it as an arm of the Democratic Party loyal to McClellan's leadership and legacy Fry in contrast shifts the story's emphasis to resurrect the successful efforts of proadministration junior officers who educated their men on the war's political dynamics and laid the groundwork for Lincoln's victory in 1864

[Lee Besieged](#) John Horn, 2025-05-31 A vivid account of Grant's daring but thwarted Second Offensive during the Petersburg siege where tactical brilliance met fierce Confederate resistance The nine month siege of Petersburg was the longest continuous operation of the Civil War Contrary to popular belief it was anything but static trench warfare as John Horn ably demonstrates in *Lee Besieged* Grant's Second Petersburg Offensive June 18 July 1 1864 Large scale Union offensives grand maneuvers that often triggered major battles broke the monotony of siege warfare Once his First Offensive the assaults of June 15 18 failed to capture the city the Union commander planned and launched his next major effort within hours This Second Offensive was one of the most dramatic operations of the entire war To pave the way for success Grant brought the city's bridges under the fire of his siege guns to slow the transfer of enemy trips in and out of Petersburg He also seized a bridgehead at Deep Bottom on James River's north bank to draw Confederate forces out of Petersburg by menacing Richmond Next he took more ambitious measures by sending infantry to hem in Petersburg from the Appomattox River below the city to the Appomattox above The move was designed to cut the critical Weldon and South Side railroads and force the Rebels to abandon Petersburg and Richmond As his infantry went to work his cavalry set out to sever the Confederate railroads below Petersburg to cut off supplies and reinforcements from the south and west Grant's opponent however was Gen Robert E Lee with his veteran infantry not the inept John Floyd of Fort Donelson or the distracted John C Pemberton of Vicksburg Lee and his infantry division commander William Mahone

marched to meet the enemy and in a stunning turn of events routed Grant's foot soldiers at Jerusalem Plank Road. Together Confederate cavalry under Wade Hampton and Mahone's infantry smashed Grant's troopers at the battles of Sappony Church and First Reams Station. Thousands of Federal prisoners flooded into Confederate camps. Not until April 1865 after seven more offensives would Grant reach the Appomattox above Petersburg and force Lee to relinquish that city and the capital of Richmond. This is tactical battle action at its finest. Horn's explanation for the context and consequences of every decision is grounded in hundreds of primary sources and supported by 40 original maps. Lee Besieged is the first full length book to put Grant's second effort into its proper perspective not only in the context of the Petersburg siege and the Civil War but in the context of warfare's history.

The Maps of the Wilderness Bradley Gottfried, 2016-03-14 The Maps of the Wilderness An Atlas of the Wilderness Campaign May 2-7 1864 continues Bradley M Gottfried's efforts to study and illustrate the major campaigns of the Civil War's Eastern Theater. This is his fifth book in the ongoing Savas Beatie Military Atlas Series. The previous four were The Maps of Gettysburg 2007 The Maps of First Bull Run 2009 The Maps of Antietam 2012 and The Maps of the Bristoe Station and Mine Run Campaigns 2013. This latest magisterial work breaks down the entire campaign and all related operational maneuvers into 24 map sets or action sections enriched with 120 original full page color maps. These spectacular cartographic creations bore down to the regimental and battery level. The Maps of the Wilderness includes an assessment of the winter of 1863-1864 the planning for the campaign the crossing of the Rapidan River and two days of bloody combat and the day of watchful stalemate thereafter. At least one and as many as eight maps accompany each action section. Opposite each map is a full facing page of detailed footnoted text describing the units personalities movements and combat including quotes from eyewitnesses depicted on the accompanying map all of which make the story of the first large scale combat of 1864 come alive. Each cartographic snapshot also serves to unlock everything ever written on the subject. This detailed coverage also includes an order of battle interview with the author bibliography and an index. This original presentation leads readers on a journey through the epic battle that would prove to be the opening salvo in a prolonged fight that would not end until the Confederates surrendered at Appomattox in April 1865. The Wilderness Campaign has two unique characteristics. First although he did not command the Army of the Potomac the battle was Ulysses S Grant's first against General Robert E Lee. Second the Wilderness fighting prolonged bloody and inconclusive is widely viewed as the most confusing action of the entire war. The dense thickets and deep smoke obscured much of what occurred during the two days of combat. Gottfried's book cuts through the confusion to deliver a clear account of the horrendous struggle. Perfect for the easy chair or for walking hallowed ground. The Maps of the Wilderness is a seminal work that like his earlier studies belongs on the bookshelf of every serious and casual student of the Civil War or in the hands of an avid enthusiast out walking the Hallowed Ground.

Wert, 2022-04-04 The struggle over the fortified Confederate position known as Spotsylvania's Mule Shoe was without parallel during the Civil War A Union assault that began at 4 30 A M on May 12 1864 sparked brutal combat that lasted nearly twenty four hours By the time Grant's forces withdrew some 55 000 men from Union and Confederate armies had been drawn into the fury battling in torrential rain along the fieldworks at distances often less than the length of a rifle barrel One Union private recalled the fighting as a seething bubbling soaring hell of hate and murder By the time Lee's troops established a new fortified line in the predawn hours of May 13 some 17 500 officers and men from both sides had been killed wounded or captured when the fighting ceased The site of the most intense clashes became forever known as the Bloody Angle Here renowned military historian Jeffry D Wert draws on the personal narratives of Union and Confederate troops who survived the fight to offer a gripping story of Civil War combat at its most difficult Wert's harrowing tale reminds us that the war's story often told through its commanders and campaigns truly belonged to the common soldier

Meade at Gettysburg Kent Masterson Brown Esq., 2021-05-03 Although he took command of the Army of the Potomac only three days before the first shots were fired at Gettysburg Union general George G Meade guided his forces to victory in the Civil War's most pivotal battle Commentators often dismiss Meade when discussing the great leaders of the Civil War But in this long anticipated book Kent Masterson Brown draws on an expansive archive to reappraise Meade's leadership during the Battle of Gettysburg Using Meade's published and unpublished papers alongside diaries letters and memoirs of fellow officers and enlisted men Brown highlights how Meade's rapid advance of the army to Gettysburg on July 1 his tactical control and coordination of the army in the desperate fighting on July 2 and his determination to hold his positions on July 3 insured victory Brown argues that supply deficiencies brought about by the army's unexpected need to advance to Gettysburg were crippling In spite of that Meade pursued Lee's retreating army rapidly and his decision not to blindly attack Lee's formidable defenses near Williamsport on July 13 was entirely correct in spite of subsequent harsh criticism Combining compelling narrative with incisive analysis this finely rendered work of military history deepens our understanding of the Army of the Potomac as well as the machinations of the Gettysburg Campaign restoring Meade to his rightful place in the Gettysburg narrative
