Information and communication technology, population movements, and climate change are also creating shared risks that must be managed at both national and international levels. Pathways for Peace is a joint United Nations World Bank Group study that originates from the conviction that the international community's attention must urgently be refocused on prevention. A scaled-up system for preventive action would save between US \$5 billion and US \$70 billion per year, which could be reinvested in reducing poverty and improving the well-being of populations. It stresses the importance of grievances related to exclusion from access to power, natural resources, security, and justice, for example, that are at the root of many violent conflicts today. Development policies and programs must be a core part of preventive efforts when risks are high or building up inclusive solutions through dialogue. Adapted macroeconomic policies, institutional reform, and redistributive policies are required. Inclusion is key, and preventive action needs to adopt a more people-centered approach that includes mainstreaming citizen engagement. Enhancing the participation of women and youth in decision-making is fundamental to sustaining peace, as well as long-term policies to address the aspirations of women and young people.
