Rabindranath Tagore was a Bengali poet, playwright, novelist, musician and artist. He won the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1913, primarily for his collection of poems *Gitanjali*. Tagore's other well-known works include *Ghare Baire* (novel), *Golpo Guccho* (short stories), *Rabindra Sangret* (songs) and *Jana Gana Mana* (India's national anthem).

This classic collection contains 18 hand-picked stories penned by the master storyteller translated from Bengali to English. They evoke the emotions of love, pain, pleasure and longing and bring to light the social hierarchy and the customs, rituals and beliefs of the people of India in the pre-Independence era.
