railroad center the Tullahoma Campaign was the beginning of the end for the Confederacy At the beginning of the war the Federals stated three major objectives that they needed to accomplish in order to be victorious First take Richmond and kill the secessionist spirit by conquering the Rebel capital This had been attempted repeatedly but never accomplished up to this point Second control the Mississippi Valley and secure the western waterways Grant had accomplished this objective by capturing Vicksburg Finally seize east Tennessee and hold the Nashville Atlanta corridor which was seen by the Federals as the major artery in the southern lifeline Rosecrans Army of the Cumberland had achieved most of this objective in the Tullahoma Campaign and Major General William T Sherman would finish the objective the following summer Winning the Tullahoma Campaign and capturing Middle Tennessee was the start of obtaining the third stated objectives [Hell by the Acre](#) Daniel A. He was the officer who took command of the CSS *Planter* in May 1862 when slaves led by Robert Smalls ran her past Confederate fortifications in Charleston harbor and delivered her to the Union fleet. He commanded a gunboat fleet on the Nansemond River that helped stop James Longstreet's advance on Norfolk. In a daring attempt to blow up Fort Fisher, the huge earthwork fortress that guarded the entrance into the Cape Fear river, he towed the USS *Louisiana*, packed with
