

lens He compares Lincoln s views on governmental powers with the defense of unlimited government by twentieth century progressives and shows how Lincoln s theory of labor anticipated twentieth century distributist economic thought Schaff's unique exploration falls squarely between historians who consider Lincoln a protoprogressive and those who say his presidency was a harbinger of industrialized corporatized America In analyzing Lincoln's approach Abraham Lincoln's Statesmanship and the Limits of Liberal Democracy rejects the idea he was a revolutionary statesman and instead lifts up Lincoln's own affinity for limited presidential power making the case for a modest approach to presidential power today based on this understanding of Lincoln's statesmanship As a counterpoint to the contemporary landscape of bitter uncivil politics Schaff points to Lincoln's statesmanship as a model for better ways of engaging in politics in a democracy
