The recent reverse vaccinology concept uses high throughput genome sequencing and bioinformatics tools to identify potential targets of immune responses The feasibility of this approach was shown for the first time in the design of a vaccine against Neisseria meningitides that is now in phase III clinical trials In addition different computational tools allow the determination of crucial gene s through
