Information Structure in a Cross-Linguistic Perspective ,2016-08-29 The present volume draws together contributions from a number of scholars with an interest in empirical cross linguistic description Most of the papers were first presented at the symposium Information Structure in a Cross linguistic Perspective held in Oslo in November December 2000 The descriptions are functionally oriented and their common focus is how information structure in a broad sense can be compared across languages Information structure has been approached in a variety of ways by the authors so as to give a broad picture of this fundamental principle of text production involving the way in which a speaker writer chooses to present a message in terms of given new information focus cohesion and point of view Central to much of the research is the problem of establishing criteria for isolating linguistic constraints on language use from cultural linguistic conventions in text production The linguistic comparison includes English German and or one of the Scandinavian languages with sidelights to other languages Most of the papers are text or corpus based and the ongoing work on parallel corpora in Scandinavia is reflected in several contributions Information Structuring of Spoken Language from a Cross-linguistic Perspective M. Clitics in Greek Marios Mavrogiorgos, 2010 This monograph investigates the morpho syntactic and other properties of clitic pronouns in Greek and offers a grammar of proclisis and enclisis in light of Chomsky's 1995 2001a 2005 Minimalist Program It explores the nature of clitics as syntactic topicalizers which are probed by structurally higher verbal heads to which they move and into which they incorporate morpho syntactically A theory is advanced according to which cliticization derives from syntactic agreement between the phi features of a clitic pronoun and a phase head v in the case of proclisis and CM in the case of enclisis Incorporation of the clitic into its host is argued to depend on two factors i e the fact that the clitic only contains a subset of the features of its host and the fact that the edge of the host is accessible Also the syntax of strong pronouns and their relation to clitics of negated imperatives of surrogate imperatives and of free clitic ordering in Greek enclisis are also discussed This monograph would appeal to syntacticians and morphologists as well as to those interested in Greek and more generally in clitic syntax

The Processing of Events Oliver Bott, 2010 Synthesizing ideas from event semantics and psycholinguistics this monograph provides a new perspective on the processing of linguistic aspect and aspectual coercion Confronting alternative semantic accounts with experimental evidence the author develops a comprehensive model of online aspectual interpretation The first part of the book critically reviews competing theoretical accounts of aspectual coercion As an analytical tool the author introduces a computational model based on the event calculus by Hamm van Lambalgen 2005 which makes use of planning formalisms from artificial intelligence Detailed predictions from this framework are then tested in the experimental work reported in the second part The focus here is on such questions as Is aspectual coercion a uniform phenomenon or must we distinguish different types Is aspect processed incrementally or is it computed only at the clause boundary And finally what insights can event related potentials yield about how the brain resolves local aspectual mismatch

Sociobiological Bases of Information Structure Viviana Masia, 2017-11-16 The book
