The global atmospheric concentration of carbon dioxide the dominant greenhouse gas of concern is increasing by roughly two parts per million per year and the United States is currently the second largest contributor to global emissions behind China Limiting the Magnitude of Future Climate Change part of the congressionally requested America's Climate Choices suite of studies focuses on the role of the United States in the global effort to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
