History in the Arab Skies Gerald Butt, 2011-07-07 History in the Arab Skies reveals the close relationship between the Middle East and flying from the earliest days of flight and analyses the decisive impact it had on the political complexion of the region from publisher description *Air Power and the Arab World 1909-1955* Dr David Nicolle, Gabr Ali Gabr, 2023-08-24 Volume 9 of the Air Power and the Arab World 1909 1955 mini series continues the story of the men and machines of the first half century of military aviation in the Arab World For those Arab nations which had some degree of independence the political cultural and economic strains seen during the Second World War continued to have a major impact not least upon their military forces In Egypt newly independent Syria and Lebanon and to a lesser extent in Iraq great effort was put into modernizing these forces Sometimes this achieved success but such efforts nevertheless failed to produce the degree of improvement which had been hoped In both Egypt and Iraq mistrust of Great Britain may even have deepened while in Palestine the worsening crisis resulted in a full blown civil war between the Zionist settler community and the indigenous Arab population The British remained in theoretical control of Palestine yet it was becoming obvious that a large part of the British government British military establishment and broader public were desperate to escape from the Palestine Problem It was also clear that the major Powers which dominated the newly established United Nations Organization had no intention of becoming militarily involved Then came the official termination of the British mandate over Palestine the declaration of the State of Israel and the start of official military intervention by the military forces of several Arab states Volume 9 covers its subject in greater detail than has been done before because the authors had access to previously unpublished official Arab military documents supplemented by translations of Arabic books and journal articles containing official and personal accounts by those involved As usual for this mini series Volume 9 is abundantly illustrated with photographs from previously unused or very rarely used private and official sources **Palestine in the Air** Chin-chin Yap, 2025-01-23 As the first cultural history of Palestinian aviation Palestine in the Air reveals civil aviation s role in the question of Palestine over the past century How do Palestinians as individuals communities and as a nascent state engage with the air How does their systemic exclusion from aerial agency inform dominant and counter narratives of culture and modernity International civil aviation is a powerful tool for the disenfranchisement of Palestinian statehood connectivity and mobility Yet Palestinians have constantly sought to harness aviation as a legitimate component of modern state building They have also creatively appropriated aviation technologies including balloons kites and drones as instruments of resistance exploiting flight s symbolic qualities of escape and liberation to highlight the injustices of occupation Using an interdisciplinary approach that draws on media studies cultural studies critical theory diplomacy and history Palestine in the Air examines civil aviation s political social and cultural impact upon the Palestinian quest for sovereignty The book makes use of an unprecedented range of aviation related sources spanning unpublished memoirs print and image archives

Anderson,2024 *A Caliphal Daedalus* examines connections between science and visual culture during the early Islamic scientific revolution of the caliphal age 650 1250 CE It takes as its point of departure the figure of Abbas Ibn Firnas d 887 the most famous scientist and polymath of early Islamic Spain The book considers his scientific activities as these intersected with design and craft culminating in the aeronautics experiment for which he is best known today as these are recounted in the *Muqtabis* the chronicle compiled by the Cordoban court historian Ibn Hayyan d 1076 It calls into question notions that medieval Islamic artisans and designers were anonymous individuals working outside elite social and intellectual circles The key passages from the chronicle are presented in English translation including the oldest and most authoritative source for the aeronautics experiment The Arabic texts are examined

in tandem with the earliest Islamic scientific instruments especially astrolabes and illustrated Arabic treatises of astronomy and engineering preserved in museums and libraries around the globe The book argues for a medieval Islamic court culture in which design and making were central to scientific intellectual pursuits and which may have shaped the culture of the Italian Renaissance
