Burleson, 2014-07-11 Howard Phillips Lovecraft 1890 1937 has been described variously as the successor to Edgar Allan Poe a master of the Gothic horror tale and one of the father of modern supernatural fantasy fiction Published originally in pulp magazines his works have grown in popularity since his death so that more than thirty editions are currently in print Yet only recently has Lovecraft received serious attention from literary critics And until now no one has examined his work from a post structuralist perspective Donald Burleson fills that void for the first time in an extended study bringing the resources of deconstruction to bear on the works of this modern gothicist In an introductory overview Burleson gives an unusually readable account of deconstruction theory and terminology a field all too often discussed in densely opaque fashion He goes on to deconstruct thirteen Lovecraft stories delving into their fascinating etymological mazes abundant ambiguities and shifting levels of meanings His lively and remarkably jargon free readings explore Lovecraft s rich figurality to unprecedented depths At the same time Burleson develops the view that in practicing self subversion and structural displacement literary texts perpetuate themselves His final chapter explores the broad themes running through Lovecraft s fiction arguing that these themes in themselves prefigure the deconstructive gesture This insightful and provocative volume will go a long way toward displacing the label of popular writer and establishing Lovecraft as an important figure in American literature **Lovecraft and Influence** Robert H. Lord Dunsany, H.P. Lovecraft, and Ray Bradbury William F. Touponce, 2013-10-10 In his classic study *Supernatural Horror in Literature*, H.P. Lovecraft discusses the emergence of what he called spectral literature, literature that involves the gothic themes of the supernatural found in the past but also considers modern society and humanity. Beyond indicating how authors of such works derived pleasure from a sense of cosmic atmosphere, Lovecraft did not elaborate on what he meant by the term spectral as a form of haunted literature concerned with modernity. In *Lord Dunsany, H.P. Lovecraft, and Ray Bradbury: Spectral Journeys*, William F. Touponce examines what these three masters of weird fiction reveal about modernity and the condition of being modern in their tales. In this study, Touponce confirms that these three authors viewed storytelling as a kind of journey into the spectral. Furthermore, he explains how each identifies modernity with capitalism in various ways and shows a concern with surpassing the limits of realism, which they see as tied to the representation of bourgeois society. The collected writings of Lord Dunsany, H.P. Lovecraft, and Ray Bradbury span the length of the tumultuous twentieth century with hundreds of stories. By comparing these authors, Touponce also traces the development of supernatural fiction since the early 1900s. Reading about how these works were tied to various stages of capitalism, one can see the connection between supernatural literature and society. This study will appeal to fans of the three authors discussed here as well as to scholars and others interested in the connection between literature and society, criticism of supernatural fiction, the nature of storytelling, and the meaning and experience of modernity.

Lovecraft, a Study in the Fantastic Maurice Lévy, 1988 Broader than a thematic

study however L vy s analysis is unique in his use of Lovecraft s work as a model for fantastic writing in general and in his provocative theory as to why Lovecraft wrote the sort of works he did Maurice L vy s book is a penetrating analysis of the themes running through the works of H P Lovecraft the writer of horror and supernatural fiction Broader than a thematic study however L vy s analysis is unique in his use of Lovecraft s work as a model for fantastic writing in general and in his provocative theory as to why Lovecraft wrote the sort of works he did At an early age Lovecraft sloughed off all religious belief and came to adopt a bleak and nihilistic philosophy where humans have no importance in the cosmos but to serve as the playthings of incomprehensible and uncaring forces L vy sees Lovecraft s works as an attempt to purge himself of these feelings and to give himself a reason to love in a universe that cares nothing for him or for other human beings in general It is this view of Lovecraft the writer the thinker and the man that sets L vy s work apart from any Lovecraft criticism

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
