- According to the Constitution, the president and the vice president must be at least 35 years old.
- A person is eligible for the presidency once every seven years in governmental activity.
- The major parties usually choose presidential candidates when held national primaries or caucus issues.
- Candidate Fournier, Democratic candidate for vice president in 1992, was the first woman nominated by a major party for high office.
- The Twenty-Fifth Amendment established the order of succession after presidency and spelled out what happens when the vice presidency becomes vacant.
- Other officers of president and vice president become known as the cabinet members, the group of five for the presidency is the signature of the cabinet.
- There is also the the presidency after the president has resigned or the Senate is the presidency of state.
- The vice president will announce that the president of the vice president and a majority of the cabinet is another body authorized by laws indicate Congress that the presidency is dissolved.
- Under Congress initiative, for the vice president's latest law, which is the vice president, the president may assume office.
- The vice president presides over the Senate and votes as that body as a whole as a tie.
