First, humans begin with their creation in the image of God. Secondly, the goal of the journey is explained as a loving union with God to achieve a share in his eternal happiness. Third, and finally, the majority of the book examines how to attain this goal. Within the journey motif, the book covers the moral principles essential for attaining true happiness. Based on an examination of the moral methodology in the Bible, the book discusses the importance of participating in divine nature through grace in order to attain eternal happiness.
