the harms of restrictive migratory control on children s wellbeing such avoiding the arrest of parents in front of children and ensuring that U S citizen children s interests are considered in immigration court without their direct involvement Surviving the ICE Age details the generational harms caused by U S immigration policy and offers suggestions for a better way forward
