

Reusing structural steel: what's in the new IStructE guide?

Florian Jones previews the guidance on reuse of structural steelwork that forms part of the Institution's forthcoming publication, *Circular economy and reuse: guidance for designers*.

As evidenced by the climate emergency fast-track in recent years, and the continued and increasing focus begun to maintain itself towards a sustainable future, there has been an increased focus on reuse of existing buildings. However, where a building cannot be repurposed or retained, it creates a secondary approach to the reuse of buildings as a potential material bank, offering a source of structural steel resources for future projects.

More recently reported steel 'circularity levels', with assessments of steel recycled to the end of its last useful life globally¹, however, with around 35% of steel used reported in the EU compared with only 25% reused², there is a clear opportunity to increase the reuse of steel. It is estimated that, in the UK, between 40–60% of steel building material could

be then using steel recycled from decommissioned buildings³.

This article provides a brief introduction to Chapter 15 of the Institution's newly released *Circular economy and reuse guide*, which focuses on reuse of steel.

What's in the guide?

Chapter 15 begins by identifying the safety and potential thermal benefits of reusing structural steelwork, with reuse steel being a carbon intensity as low as 100kgCO₂e/t⁴, compared with a steel of average of 1,100kgCO₂e/t for new steelwork⁵. It then considers the benefits of reusing project and global emissions, noting that, as a result of reuse, if reused steel increases the total steel tonnage of a design by more than 30% compared with a new

steel, it may be better than a green steelwork for reducing the steel.

This chapter then goes on to look at options for reusing structural steelwork and the guide to available resources. These are first listed as presented in descending order from highest to lowest potential and then categorised as follows:

- 1. Reuse of steelwork in situ within an existing building
- 2. Reuse of steelwork as part of an existing steel-framed structure in a different location
- 3. Reuse of individual members as is, or with limited reworking
- 4. Reuse of steelwork as scrap

Figure 15.1 is a broad overview of the guide, with Chapter 15 focusing on options 3–4 which require reclamation of the steel.
