

These people are considered bereft of any ability to reason think or feel yet ambulant and able to respond to surrounding stimuli However it is difficult to imagine crime especially those involving a group of people working together for the duration of a particular criminal activity without emotions For instance there is ample evidence suggesting that both crimes of passion and pre meditated crimes involve emotional arousal Furthermore research in fields such as evolutionary biology psychology and sociology of work and organizations suggest that emotions are essential for human progress and survival In addition emotions help us make the right call in risky and uncertain situations in other words the majority of real life situations There is therefore a need to revisit existing assumptions around the role of emotions in mass atrocities
