Make a Beautiful Way Barbara Alice Mann, 2008-07-01 *Make a Beautiful Way* is nothing less than a new way of looking at history or more correctly the reestablishment of a very old way. For too long Euro American discourse styles emphasizing elite male privilege and conceptual linearity have drowned out democratic and woman centered Native approaches. Even when myopic western linearity is understood to be at work, analysis of Native American history, society and culture has still been consistently placed in male custody. The recovery of women's traditions is the overarching theme in this collection of essays that helps reframe Native issues as properly gendered. Paula Gunn Allen looks at Indian lifeways through the many stitches of Indian clothes and the many steps of their powwow fancy dances. Lee Maracle calls for reconstitution of traditional social structures based on Native American ways of knowing. Kay Givens McGowan identifies the exact sites where female power was weakened through the imposition of European culture so that we might more effectively strengthen precisely those sites. By giving a voice to Oneida women's thoughts on tradition and nation, this book challenges mainstream feminist ideas about the masculine bias of Western theories of nation and about the dangers of nationalist movements that idealize women's so called traditional role. Lina Sunseri shows that feminist insights, although useful to many women's and feminist groups, cannot be applied universally to all women or to societies with traditional forms of nation based on good relations between men and women. Oneida women do not view nationalism as a threat but rather as a way for women and men to be again of one mind. **Daughters of Aataentsic** Kathryn Magee Labelle, 2021-03-10 *Daughters of Aataentsic* highlights and connects the unique lives of seven Wendat/Wendat women whose legacies are still felt today. Spanning the continent and the colonial borders of New France, British North America, Canada and the United States, this book shows how Wendat people and place came together in Ontario, Quebec, Michigan, Ohio, Kansas and Oklahoma and how generations of activism became intimately tied with notions of family, community, motherwork and legacy from the seventeenth to the twenty first century. The lives of the seven women tell a story of individual and community triumph despite difficulties and great loss. Kathryn Magee Labelle aims to decolonize the historical discipline by researching with Indigenous people rather than researching on them. It is a collaborative effort guided by an advisory council of eight Wendat/Wendat women reflecting the needs and desires of

community members Daughters of Aataentsic challenges colonial interpretations by demonstrating the centrality of women past and present to Wendat Wandat culture and history Labelle draws from institutional archives and published works as well as from oral histories and private collections Breaking new ground in both historical narratives and community guided research in North America Daughters of Aataentsic offers an alternative narrative by considering the ways in which individual Wendat Wandat women resisted colonialism preserved their culture and acted as matriarchs
