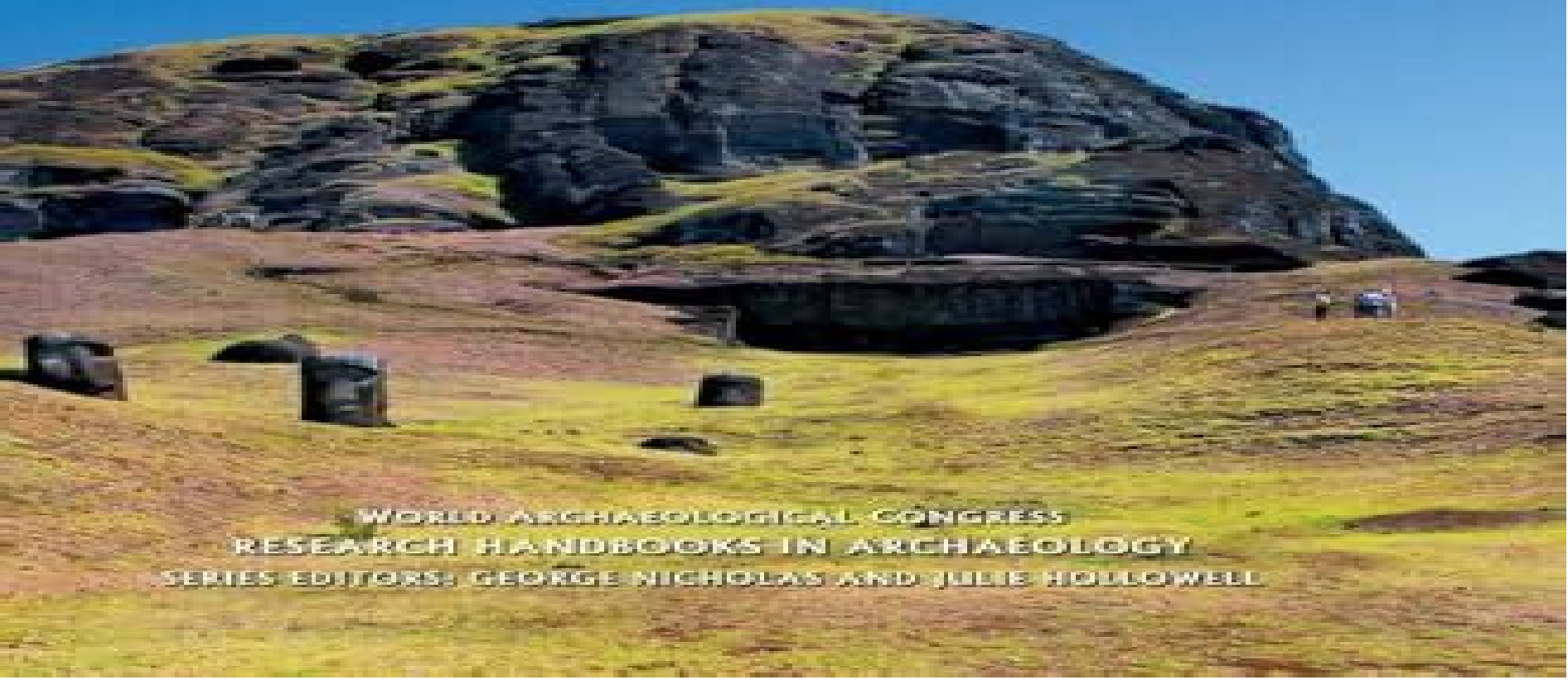

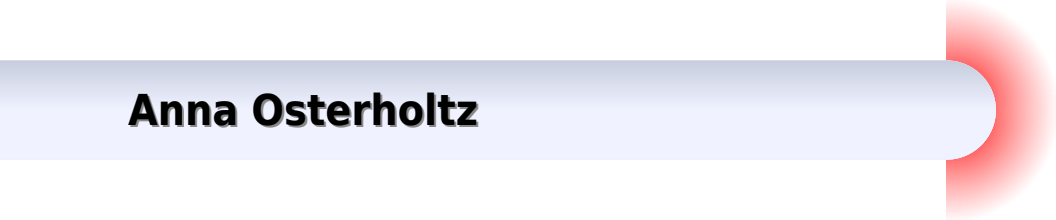

Landscape Geraldine Mate,2022-09-12 Mining was one of the primary elements of colonial enterprise in Australia and a
factor in movement on colonial frontiers In the second half of the 19th and early 20th century mining particularly of gold saw
transformations of the land itself as well as in the way that people working in mining engaged with the landscape around
them Landscape archaeology provides a theoretical perspective that allows an articulation of how people created and

understood the place in which they lived and worked The impact of and narrative surrounding gold mining has meant that it has long been a focus of study both historical and archaeological The archaeology of mining has traditionally fallen under the umbrella of industrial archaeology with analyses based on historical economic and technological evidence However this is changing From an industrial focus examining the remnants of mines and associated processing equipment archaeology has progressed towards understandings of the social aspects of mining recognising that people not just equipment occupied these landscapes Nevertheless there remains a separation between industrial technology based studies and purely social household based archaeological studies a division that overlooks the integration of home and livelihood This work addresses these very challenges using a landscape based approach that articulates a nuanced meaning laden and experienced mining landscape Integrating the social and the industrial the case study of Mount Shamrock a gold mining town in Queensland Australia demonstrates how this methodology can enhance our understanding of the past The work presents an integration of social and industrial perspectives in a mining settlement and provides an exemplar in the application of landscape theory to Australian historical archaeology These concepts and approaches developed in an Australian context are of universal interest

Native American Landscapes Cheryl Claassen, 2024-01-12 This collection of essays focuses on what Cheryl Claassen terms the multi vocal landscape the idea that different groups and genders look upon the same natural features but perceive different meanings and potential in what they are seeing Through ten chapters various contributors showcase the ways in which native peoples see and interact with the natural world At the heart of this book is the idea that Europeans associated nature with the feminine and saw the natural world as a passive frontier to be dominated Native Americans however looked at landscape differently They saw nature as a place in which to engage in complex negotiations between spirits and humans This approach to nature cemented a relationship to the land based more on a partnership rather than subjugation These essays deepen our understanding of the interaction between native people and the land While other

books focus on the gendered gaze of European men upon the landscape this collection emphasizes that native men and native women looked upon natural formations and constructed landscapes differently from one another a difference in perception that is important for archaeologists and anthropologists to understand While there have been advances toward admitting this more complex view in the rest of the world Native American Landscapes is the first to focus on how native men and women viewed the world around them Native American Landscapes is organized by region taking readers across the country from the rock shelters of the Cumberland Plateau in the east to the Mojave Desert and the Mexican Gulf Coast then north to what is now British Columbia and farther west to Hawaii Readers of this collection through a study of creation myths vision quests fertility shrines and other ritualized uses of landscape will learn more about the land and about humans perception of our natural surroundings which forms the bedrock of our present relationship with the natural world CHERYL CLAASSEN is professor of anthropology at Appalachian State University She is the author or editor of six books on Native American prehistory including Feasting with Shellfish in the Southern Ohio Valley Shells Rituals and Beliefs in Archaic North America and Women in Prehistory North America and Mesoamerica

Re-activating Indigenous Knowledge from Oral History Asta Mønsted, 2025-09-11 This book focuses on Greenlandic oral history and how to better understand people their cultural remains and their landscape through their own stories It offers a way to consult Inuit oral history that opens up a perspective on houses and landscapes that may otherwise be invisible to the barren eye Working with and re-activating Indigenous knowledge of Greenland the study draws on more than two thousand stories collected between 1735 and 1981 preserved and later enrolled in an online and searchable database The author unearths the concepts woven into Greenlandic Inuit's homes settlements and landscapes These re-discovered insights challenge the archaeological interpretation transcending the tangible to illuminate the unseen The narratives contribute to safeguarding invaluable Indigenous knowledge and perhaps also to the revival of cultural practices customs and traditions The book demonstrates how oral history is more than merely fantastical myths and legends it is valuable knowledge for scholars and communities It will be of particular interest for scholars of Indigenous studies anthropology archaeology and history

Trubitt,2024-04-04 A comprehensive view of quarrying activities from three key regions in North America This exciting new addition to the the American Landscapes series provides an in depth account of how flintknappers obtained and used stone based on archaeological geological landscape and anthropological data Featuring case studies from three key regions in North America this book gives readers a comprehensive view of quarrying activities ranging from extracting the raw material to creating finished stone tools Quarry landscapes were some of the first large scale land modification efforts among early peoples in the New World The chronological time periods covered by quarrying activities show that most intensive use took place during parts of the Archaic and Woodland periods or between roughly 4000 1000 years ago when denser populations existed but use began as early as the Paleoindian Period about 13 000 9000 years ago and ended in the Historic or Protohistoric periods when colonists and Native Americans mined chert for gunflints and sharpening stones or abrasives From the procurement systems approach common in the 1980s and 1990s archaeologists can now employ a landscape approach to quarry studies in tandem with Geographic Information Systems GIS computer mapping and digital analysis Light and RADAR LiDAR airborne laser scanning for recording topography or high resolution satellite imagery Authors Dowd and Trubitt show how sites functioned in a broad landscape context which site locations or raw material types were preferred and why what cultures were responsible for innovative or intensive quarry resource extraction as well as how land use changed over time Besides discussions of the way that industrialists used natural resources to change their technology by means of manufacture trade and exchange examples are given of heritage sites that people can visit in the United States and Canada

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
