climate of Anglo American exchange as registered by each poet The book's presentation of the process of poetic influence is attentive to actual exchanges between contemporaries as evidenced in correspondence as opposed to speculative relationships with dominant figures and as such represents a departure from many other studies of Ashbery's work Key themes include Englishness as a national imaginary the concept of the minor reciprocal influence and the poetry of coteries. The result is that both Ashbery himself and the landscape of post war English poetry are presented in significantly new lights
