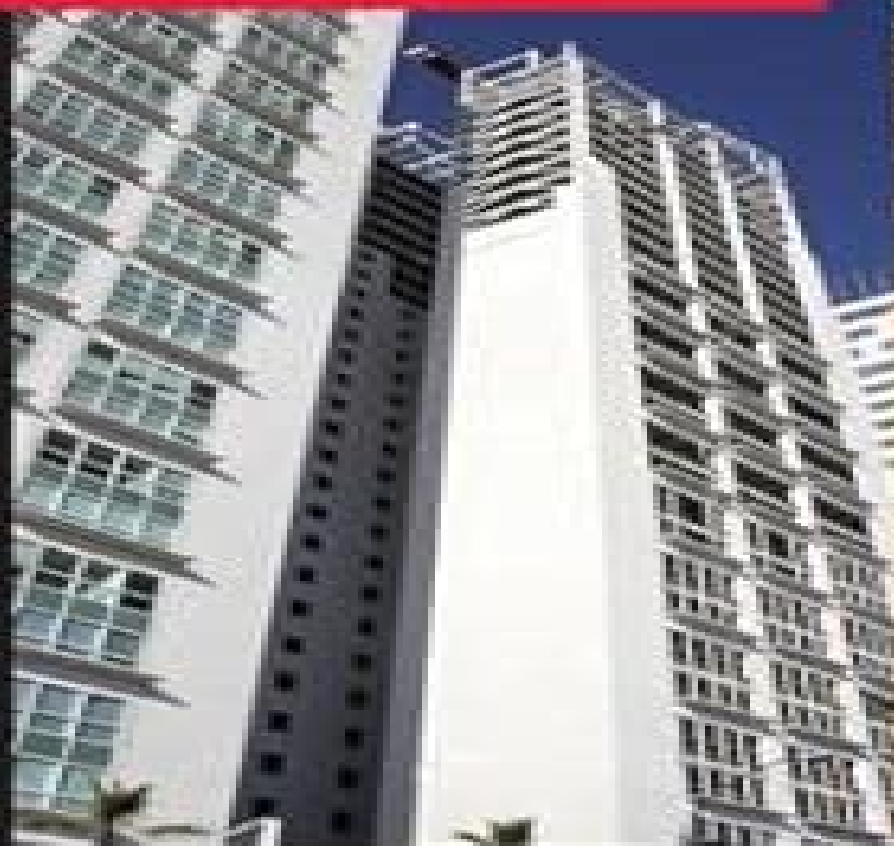

Looney, 2018-10-03 International trade has for decades been central to economic growth and improved standards of living for nations and regions worldwide For most of the advanced countries trade has raised standards of living while for most emerging economies growth did not begin until their integration into the global economy The economic explanation is simple international trade facilitates specialization increased efficiency and improved productivity to an extent impossible in closed economies However recent years have seen a significant slowdown in global trade and the global system has increasingly come under attack from politicians on the right and on the left The benefits of open markets the continuation of international co operation and the usefulness of multilateral institutions such as the World Trade Organization WTO the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank have all been called into question While globalization has had a broadly positive effect on overall global welfare it has also been perceived by the public as damaging communities and social classes in the industrialized world spawning for example Brexit and the US exit from the Trans Pacific Partnership The purpose of this volume is to examine international and regional preferential trade agreements PTAs which offer like minded countries a possible means to continue receiving the benefits of economic liberalization and expanded trade What are the strengths and weaknesses of such agreements and how can they sustain growth and prosperity for their members in an ever challenging global economic environment The Handbook is divided into two parts The first Global Themes offers analysis of issues including the WTO trade agreements and economic development intellectual property rights security and environmental issues and PTAs and developing countries The second part examines regional and country specific agreements and issues including NAFTA CARICOM CETA the Pacific Alliance the European Union EFTA ECOWAS SADC TTIP RCEP and the TPP now the CPTPP as well as the policies of countries such as Japan and Australia

The Securitisation of Climate Change and the Governmentalisation of Security Franziskus von Lucke, 2020-10-01

This book provides an in depth analysis of the securitisation of climate change in the US Germany and Mexico and offers a rethinking of securitisation theory. Resting on a Foucauldian governmentality approach it discusses how different climate security discourses have transformed the political handling of climate change and affected policies practices and institutions. Going beyond the literature's predominant focus on the global level it gives a fine grained examination of the political and institutional changes in different national contexts. Drawing on the governmentalisation of security the book develops a new understanding of securitisation that focuses on the role of power. In doing so it provides new insights into the transformative potential of linking climate change to security but also highlights the political and normative pitfalls of securitisation. In this important book Franziskus von Lucke provides a theoretically sophisticated and empirically rich account of the relationship between security and climate change. Developing a Foucauldian inspired account of securitization the book rejects blanket or universal claims about the climate change security relationship instead insisting on the need to critically examine how the securitization of climate change plays out in particular empirical contexts. Exploring the cases of the US Germany and Mexico von Lucke points to distinctive dynamics of securitization in these settings with different implications for the practices these in turn encourage. Ultimately this book constitutes an important addition to literature on the relationship between climate change and security while developing a distinct and nuanced account of securitization that will be of interest to a wide range of scholars of security in international relations.

Associate Professor Matt McDonald is a Reader in International Relations at the University of Queensland Australia. In 2019 a number of states and other actors notably the European Union have made climate emergency declarations. It is therefore more important than ever to understand what the securitization of the climate means. That is Who can securitize? What security measures are likely deemed legitimate by relevant audiences? How does securitization affect the population within and outside a securitizing state? And perhaps most importantly of all will it succeed?

Franziskus von Lucke's carefully researched book offers answers to all of these questions and many others. Besides von Lucke proceeds by examining with the US Mexico and Germany three real life empirical cases of climate securitization. Each one provides unique insights that enable a fuller understanding of climate security.

China's Belt and Road Initiative at Ten Robert Looney, 2022-11-23 This volume assesses China's Belt and Road Initiative BRI as it approaches its tenth year in operation The programme has gone through a difficult transition since its inception in 2013 with an environment developing in a way utterly unanticipated by Chinese decision makers Despite pragmatic adjustments to the BRI the lack of a firm empirical base has impeded the BRI and led to its demise in many countries With the accumulation of nearly ten years of project and economic data it is possible to make an in depth assessment of the BRI For this purpose the study examines the infrastructure component of the BRI in 39 countries stretching from the Americas to Oceania and finally South Asia The study finds a strong relationship between a country's progress in improved governance and the quality of its infrastructure Countries that have benefited from the BRI have simultaneously achieved progress in governance areas such as the rule of law and control of corruption By not emphasizing improved governance structures China condemns many of its partners to failure Researchers students and economic development specialists from Latin America to South Asia and Oceania will find this study a useful departure from the volumes of anecdotal BRI assessments
