Specifying tighter target ranges for fully articoagulated patients e.g. 2.0—2.5 or 5.5—40 does not achieve tighter anticoagulation control but results in more blood tests and more INR results in ranges associated with increased risk of throughoute and blooding (bloier et al., 2007).

t. I. Venous themselventholine: (VTE)

For acute WTE warfarin should be started along with a purcenteral envisoragealant, such as undirectionated hoperin CUFFO, lose molecular weight hoperin (EMWH) or fundaparinus (Franchies et al. 1992), which should be continued for at least 5 d and until the INR is 22 for at least 2d h, whichever is the longer.

For the initial period of treatment the target INR should be 2.5. For patients who require anticoagulation beyond 5 months, it is not recommended to lower the target range after 5 months as this has been shown to offer power efficacy with comparable bleeding rates (Remon et al. 2003). Ridder et al. 2000).

Potients who suffer a recurrence of VTE whilst on anticoagulants, where the anticoagulant control is within target, need escalation of their INR target. There are few data that relate to this scenario, but we suggest a target of 3.5.

- First episodes of VTE should be treated with an INR target of 2-3 (LA).
- Warfarin used for treatment of VTE should be introduced along with purenteral anticongulation (IA) which should continue for at least 5-d and until the INR is 22 for at least 24 h (IC).
- Recurrent VTE whilst arrice againsted and within the therapeutic range should be managed by increasing the INE target to 3-5 (2C).
