Yet more remains to be known. Passing remarks about Pascual Jordan's Nazi collaboration, about genetics and intelligence, and about "mass murder" weapons (atomic bombs?) are simply too sketchy to allow full compre-

Casimir actually does write about such informative (and sometimes equally amusing) topics as the nature of the physics profession when he entered it, the pedagogy of his three outstanding teachers, and the expected career opportunities (mainly in secondary school teaching).
