The book also demonstrates how women have contributed to the evolution of soundscapes, the genre of essay cinema, film's relationship to the archive and the adaptation of the written word. The result is a powerful, provocative and definitive challenge to the marginalisation of Portuguese female directed film in terms of double minority.

Seeing Politics Otherwise Patricia I. Vieira, 2011-01-01 When confronting twentieth century political oppression and violence, writers and artists in Portugal and South America have often emphasized the complex relationship between freedom and tyranny. In *Seeing Politics Otherwise*, Patricia Vieira uses an interdisciplinary approach to explore the interrelation of politics and representations of vision and blindness in Latin American and Iberian literature, film and art.
