Symposium Plato, 1924 *On the Revolutions of Heavenly Spheres* Nicolaus Copernicus, 2010-08-27 The Ptolemaic system of the universe with the earth at the center had held sway since antiquity as authoritative in philosophy science and church teaching Following his observations of the heavenly bodies Nicolaus Copernicus 1473 1543 abandoned the geocentric system for a heliocentric model with the sun at the center His remarkable work *On the Revolutions of Heavenly Spheres* stands as one of the greatest intellectual revolutions of all time and profoundly influenced among others Galileo and Sir Isaac Newton **Problems of Philosophy**, 1973 *On the Motion of the Heart and Blood in Animals* William Harvey, William Harvey 1578 1657 was a rebel in medical science Contrary to contemporary practice he began his epoch making investigation into the action of the heart and the blood s circulation by minutely observing their action in live animals and by a lengthy series of dissections rather than by mere reliance on the anatomical lessons of ancient medicine and philosophy *On the Motion of the Heart and Blood in Animals* including explanations of heart valves and arterial pulse stands as a triumph of true scientific inquiry and is still regarded as one of the greatest discoveries in physiology **Agnosticism and Christianity and Other Essays** Thomas Henry Huxley, 2010-04-06 In this selection of his most important writings renowned scientist and philosopher Thomas Henry Huxley 1825 1895 discusses his views on the demonstrative evidence of evolution the physical basis of life naturalism and supernaturalism agnosticism and Christianity and the Christian tradition in relation to Judaic Christianity **Life of Reason** George Santayana, 1990 Comparing the lived world with the ideal world noted American philosophical naturalist poet and literary critic George Santayana 1863 1952 seeks in this influential compilation of his earlier works to outline the ancient ideal of a well ordered life one in which reason is the organizing force that recognizes the need to allocate science religion art social concerns and practical wisdom their proper role and appropriate emphasis within the fully developed human experience **Outlines of Pyrrhonism** Sextus Empiricus, 2023-11-14 Throughout history philosophers have sought to define understand and delineate concepts important to human well being One such concept is knowledge Many philosophers believed that absolute certain knowledge is possible that the physical world and ideas formulated about it could be given solid foundation unaffected by the varieties of mere opinion Sextus Empiricus stands as an example of the skeptic school of thought whose members believed that knowledge was either unattainable or if a genuine possibility the conditions necessary to achieve it were next to impossible to satisfy In other words in the absence of complete knowledge one must make do with the information provided by an imperfect world and conveyed to the mind through sense impressions that can often deceive us Throughout his life Sextus Empiricus entered into intellectual combat with those who confidently claimed to possess indubitable knowledge For skeptics the best one can hope to achieve is a reasonable suspension of judgment remaining ever mindful that claims to knowledge require careful scrutiny thoughtful analysis and critical review if we are to prevent

ourselves and others from plunging headlong into mistaken notions

Wells, 2011-06-03 In this superb little book written during World War II historian sociologist and novelist H G Wells 1866 1946 contemplates the belief systems prejudices and institutions that have brought humankind to a dreadful impasse where it stands at the brink of destruction or of a new beginning In his lucid summary of modern ideas concerning the fundamentals and ultimates of existence Wells points out how absurd and outmoded religious beliefs marked by intolerance hatred and exclusion have poisoned human beings relations with the world and each other These need to be replaced by a new social morality and a heightened sense of humankind's proper place in a dynamic universe

The Spirit of Laws Baron De Montesquieu, Charles De Secondat, One of the most influential books of all time this masterpiece of political philosophy was widely read throughout Europe attracted an especially enthusiastic readership in England and had a profound effect on the framers of the American Constitution Montesquieu 1689 1755 already famous and controversial through his Persian Letters a

work of his youth in which he humorously satirized the foibles of French society turned in his later years to this serious treatise on the nature of law But though the subject itself was profound this gravitas did not inhibit the famous Montesquieu wit Master of the pithy bon mot he managed to survey a great deal of political and philosophical territory while keeping his readers charmed with memorable and artfully turned phrases Liberty he says consists in the ability to do what one ought to desire and in not being forced to do what one ought not to desire Concerning the unpopularity of the English in France he says it is due to their arrogance which is such that even in peace they seem to negotiate with none but enemies The scope of this masterful work is truly prodigious Montesquieu explores the essentials of good government compares and contrasts despotism monarchy and democracy and discusses the factors that lead to corruption of governments Among the many other topics considered are education of the citizenry crime and punishment abuse of power and of liberty individual rights taxation slavery the role of women the influence of climate on the temper of a people and their form of government commerce religion and a host of additional subjects The Spirit of Laws is essential and genuinely enjoyable reading for anyone interested in the development of democracy

Walter Lippmann,2012-03-20 A Preface to Politics 1913 was the first book of political commentary published by Walter Lippmann one of the most widely read and influential journalists of the 20th century Shortly after its publication Lippmann

cofounded The New Republic magazine in which he regularly published the kind of astute political analysis that he debuted in *A Preface to Politics*. He later served in the administration of Woodrow Wilson and had a decisive influence on the formulation of Wilson's famous Fourteen Points. But his greatest influence came from the popular syndicated column called *Today and Tomorrow* which he wrote for thirty years. At its height 250 newspapers across the nation carried Lippmann's column and eventually it won two Pulitzer Prizes. A prevailing theme throughout the essays in *A Preface to Politics* is that successful politicians are those who know how to tap into public needs and give voice to the concerns of the common man. The inherent logic and intellectual respectability of any particular policy are less important, Lippmann says, than its ability to arouse the emotions and express the deep feelings of a constituency. He points to Theodore Roosevelt as the prime example in his day of a politician who understood how to rally the public behind a cause. He also comments extensively on socialism which was a rising political force in the beginning of the 20th century. Though he felt some sympathy with the socialist cause in this early work, he also astutely points out its many weaknesses. Later in his career Lippmann turned completely away from socialism. A book of both historical interest and of enduring insights into the political process, *A Preface to Politics* will enhance the bookshelves of journalists, political scientists, historians, and all who value good writing.

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
