H.P. Lovecraft is the most important and influential horror writer of the twentieth century. His stories of cosmic nightmare and cosmic horror have drawn praise from William S. Burroughs, Agatha Christie and Jorge Luis Borges and continue to inspire new generations of writers and artists.
