Jørgensen, 2010-07-05 Elena Poniatowska is one of Latin America's most distinguished and innovative living writers. Advocacy of women and the poor in their struggle for social and economic justice, denunciation of the repression of that struggle and a tendency to blur the boundaries between conventional literary forms characterize her writing practice. Asserting that Poniatowska's writing has been uniquely shaped by her experience as a journalist and interviewer, Beth Jørgensen addresses four important texts: *Palabras cruzadas* (interviews), *Hasta no verte Jesús mío* (testimonial novel), *La noche de Tlatelolco* (oral history), and *La flor de lis* (novel of development). She also treats related pieces including *Lilus Kikus* (short fiction), *De noche vienes* (short stories), *Fuerte es el silencio* (chronicles), and several of Poniatowska's essays. Her readings incorporate a variety of critical approaches within a feminist framework.

Hasta No Verte Jesus Mio Elena Poniatowska, 1993-01-01 [The Shattered Mirror](#) María Elena de Valdés, 2010-07-05 Popular images of women in Mexico conveyed through literature and more recently film and television were long restricted to either the stereotypically submissive wife and mother or the demonized fallen woman. But new representations of women and their roles in Mexican society have shattered the ideological mirrors that reflected these images. This book explores this major change in the literary representation of women in Mexico. María Elena de Valdés enters into a selective and hard-hitting examination of literary representation in its social context and a contestatory engagement of both the literary text and its place in the social reality of Mexico. Some of the topics she considers are Carlos Fuentes and the subversion of the social codes for women, the poetic ties between Sor Juana Inés de la Cruz and Octavio Paz, questions of female identity in the writings of Rosario Castellanos, Luisa Josefina Hernández, María Luisa Puga, and Elena Poniatowska, the Chicana writing of Sandra Cisneros, and the postmodern celebration without reprobation of being a woman in Laura Esquivel's *Like Water for Chocolate*.

Through Their Eyes Nathaniel Gardner, Nathaniel Eli Gardner, 2007 Even though Elena Poniatowska is considered to be one of the most important female writers in present-day Mexico, few book-length studies have been dedicated to her work. This book focuses on the writings of Elena Poniatowska and also on the work of her former students, Silvia Molina and Rosa Nissén. A brief history of the literary workshop that links the three together is also provided. Although the three writers are quite different in several respects, they share one common element that is central to their writings: the depiction of marginal members of society. With reference to *Subaltern Studies*, this study analyses how the subaltern is represented in the works of each writer.
