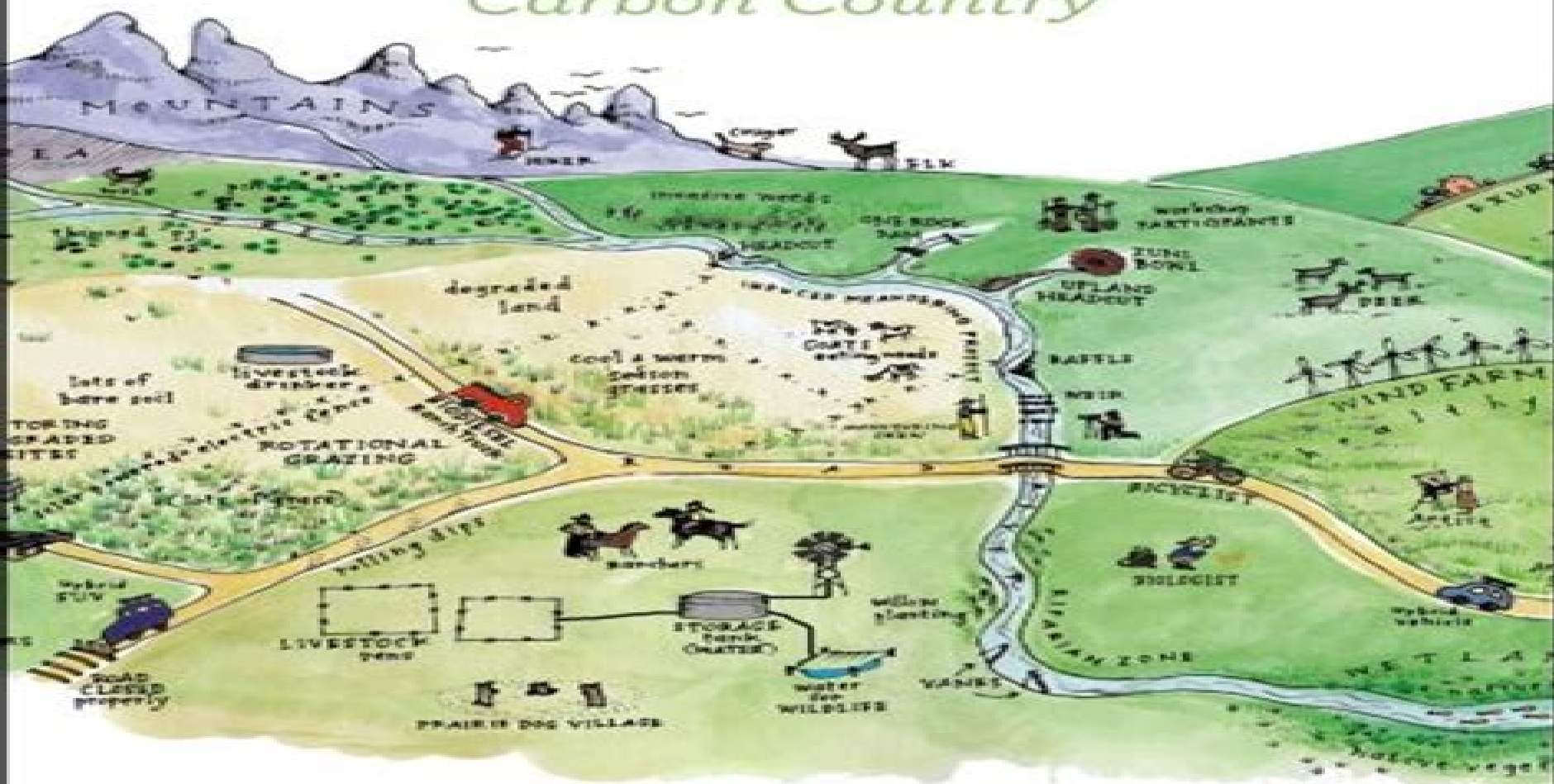

Grass, Soil, Hope Courtney White, 2014-05-23 What can we do about the seemingly intractable challenges confronting all of humanity today including climate change global hunger water scarcity environmental stress and economic instability The quick answers are Build topsoil Fix creeks Eat meat from pasture raised animals Scientists maintain that a mere 2 percent increase in the carbon content of the planet's soils could offset 100 percent of all greenhouse gas emissions going into the atmosphere But how could this be accomplished What would it cost Is it even possible Yes says author Courtney White it is not only possible but essential for the long term health and sustainability of our environment and our economy Right now the only possibility of large scale removal of greenhouse gases from the atmosphere is through plant photosynthesis and related land based carbon sequestration activities These include a range of already existing low tech and proven practices composting no till farming climate friendly livestock practices conserving natural habitat restoring degraded watersheds and rangelands increasing biodiversity and producing local food In Grass Soil Hope the author shows how all these practical strategies can be bundled together into an economic and ecological whole with the aim of reducing atmospheric CO₂ while producing substantial co benefits for all living things Soil is a huge natural sink for carbon dioxide If we can draw increasing amounts carbon out of the atmosphere and store it safely in the soil then we can significantly address all the multiple challenges that now appear so intractable

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Two Percent Solutions for the Planet Courtney White, 2015-09-21 Two Percent Solutions for the Planet profiles fifty innovative practices that soak up carbon dioxide in soils reduce energy use sustainably intensify food production and increase water quality The two percent refers to

Meandering is an artful blend of the natural sciences geomorphology hydrology and ecology which govern channel forming processes Induced Meandering directly challenges the dominant paradigm of river and creek stabilization by promoting the intentional erosion of selected banks while fostering deposition of eroded materials on an evolving floodplain The river self heals as the growth of native riparian vegetation accelerates the meandering process Not all stream channel types are appropriate for Induced Meandering yet the Induced Meandering philosophy of going with the flow can inform all stream restoration projects Induced meandering strives to understand rivers as timeless entities governed by immutable rules serving their watersheds setting their own timetables and coping with their own realities as they carry mountains grain by grain to the sea Anyone with an interest in natural resource management in these uncertain times should read this book and put these ideas to work

Defending Beef Nicolette Hahn Niman, 2014-10-31 For decades it has been nearly universal dogma among environmentalists and health advocates that cattle and beef are public enemy number one But is the matter really so clear cut Hardly argues environmental lawyer turned rancher Nicolette Hahn Niman in her new book *Defending Beef* The public has long been led to believe that livestock especially cattle erode soils pollute air and water damage riparian areas and decimate wildlife populations In *Defending Beef* Hahn Niman argues that cattle are not inherently bad for either the Earth or our own nutritional health In fact properly managed livestock play an essential role in maintaining grassland ecosystems by functioning as surrogates for herds of wild ruminants that once covered the globe Hahn Niman argues that dispersed grass fed small scale farms can and should become the basis for American food production replacing the factory farms that harm animals and the environment The author a longtime vegetarian goes on to dispel popular myths about how eating beef is bad for our bodies She methodically evaluates health claims made against beef demonstrating that such claims have proven false She shows how foods from cattle milk and meat particularly when raised entirely on grass are healthful extremely nutritious and an irreplaceable part of the world's food system Grounded in empirical scientific data and with living examples from around the world *Defending Beef* builds a comprehensive argument that cattle can help to build carbon sequestering soils to mitigate climate change enhance biodiversity help prevent desertification and provide invaluable nutrition *Defending Beef* is simultaneously a book about big ideas and the author's own personal tale she starts out as a skeptical vegetarian and eventually becomes an enthusiastic participant in environmentally sustainable ranching While no single book can definitively answer the thorny question of how to feed the Earth's growing population *Defending Beef* makes the case that whatever the world's future food system looks like cattle and beef can and must be part of the solution
