the American invasion force was to pass through this area and that would only happen if the 505 held Ste Mere Eglise It was an almost unimaginable challenge at ten that morning the German attacks began and by early afternoon enemy armored columns were slamming GI lines from three directions in an attempt to reach the vulnerable invasion beaches But despite heavy losses the 505 was still in control of Ste Mere Eglise on June 8 when they were relieved by units that came across the beach When their unseasoned replacements faltered U S commanders called on the exhausted paratroopers to stay in the fight and lead the series of ground assaults that would secure the invasion A single unit a relative handful of men had helped turn the course of one of the most important battles of the war **Hunting** Jan E.
