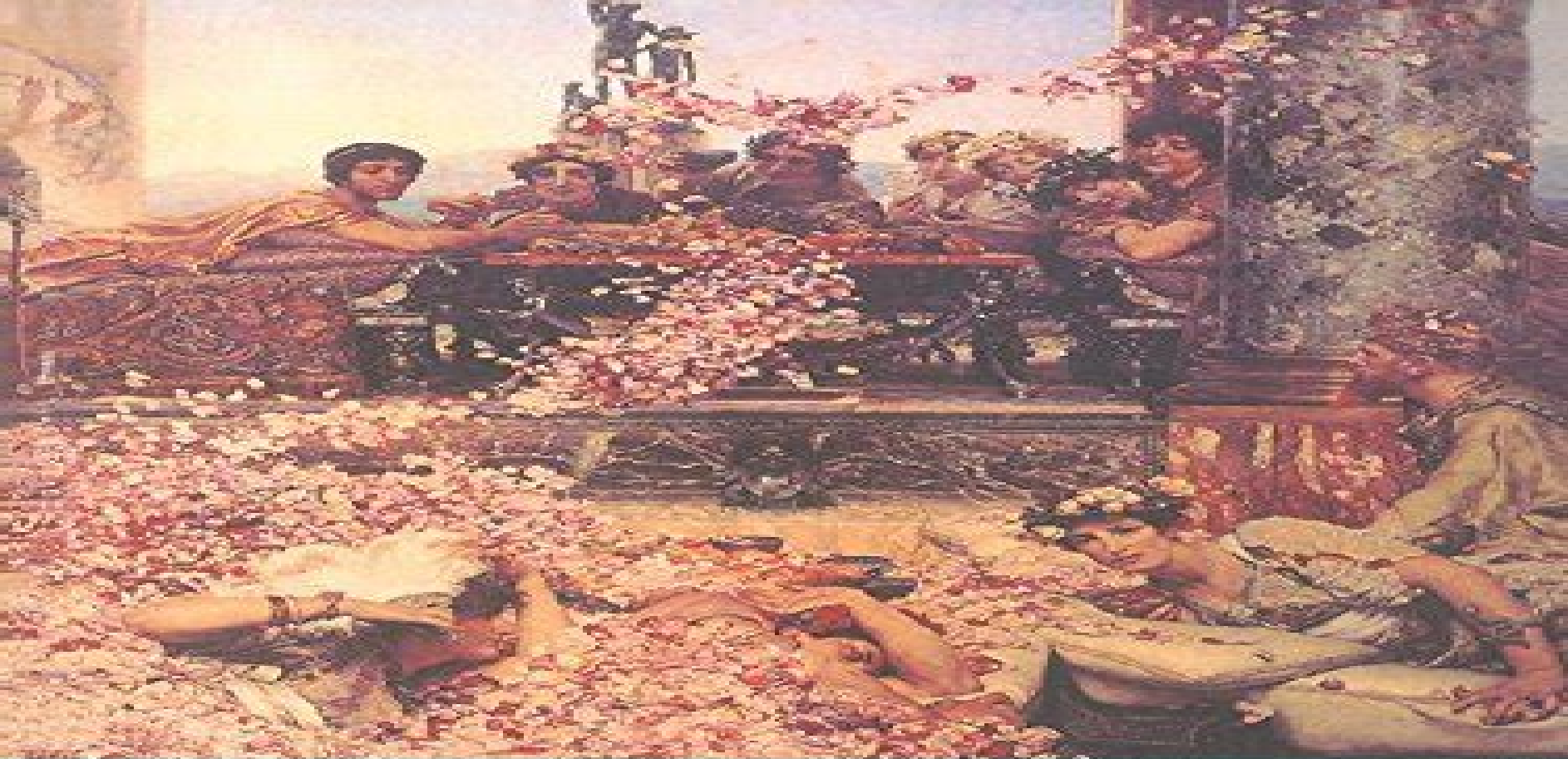

Wallace,John Gach,2010-04-13 Most of the prefatory issues are extensively elaborated upon in the Prolegomenon which also contains the complete references to the texts and authors discussed below Nevertheless the Preface would be grossly incomplete without touching on some of these issues books and scholars Too many of this book s chapters e g Mora s Marx s D B Weiner s examine and reference important earlier as well as contemporary general histories of psychiatry and specialized monographs in German French Italian and Spanish Also in his 1968 Short History of Psychiatry discussed below Ackerknecht pp xi xii references important nineteenth and earlier twentieth century psychiatric histories in English French and German Such citations will of course not be repeated here Finally thanks to several publishers re editions of dozens of classical psychiatric texts one can consult their bibliographies as well See Prolegomenon for references to these splendid series In a rough and ready sense medical history began in classical Greece for example On Ancient Medicine While traditionally included in the Hippocratic corpus this text seems more likely to have been written by a non or even anti Hippocratic doctor Moreover the Hippocratic and other schools were hardly as secular as we now suppose On Epilepsy for example does not so much declare the prevalent denotation of it as the sacred disease erroneous as it does that it is no more nor less sacred than any other disease

Questioning the Historicity of Jesus Raphael Lataster,2019-07-01 This volume moves beyond the mainstream scholarly scepticism over the Christ of Faith and considers if there is sufficient evidence to establish the existence of the more mundane Historical Jesus Using the logical tools of the analytic philosopher Lataster finds that the relevant sources are unreliable as historical documents and that the key method of those purporting that the Historical Jesus existed is to appeal to sources that do not exist Considering an ancient hypothesis suggesting that Jesus began as a celestial messiah that certain Second Temple Jews already believed in and was later allegorised in the Gospels Lataster discovers that it is more reasonable to at least be agnostic over Jesus historicity

Simon of Samaria and the Simonians M. David Litwa,2024-03-07 Who were the Simonians Beginning in the mid second century CE heresiologists depicted them as licentious followers of the first gnostic a supposedly Samaritan self deifier called Simon who was thought to practice magic and became known as the father of all heresies Litwa examines the Simonians in their own literature and in the literature used to refute and describe them He begins with Simonian primary sources namely The Declaration of Great Power embedded in the anonymous Refutation of All Heresies and The Concept of Our Great Power Nag Hammadi codex VI 4 Litwa argues that both are early second century

products of Simonian authors writing in Alexandria or Egypt Litwa then moves on to examine the heresiological sources related to the Simonians Justin the book of Acts Irenaeus the author of the Refutation of All Heresies Pseudo Tertullian Epiphanius and Filaster He shows how closely connected Justin s report is to the portrait of Simon in Acts and offers an extensive exegesis and analysis of Simonian theology and practice based on the reports of Irenaeus and the Refutator Finally Litwa examines Simonianism in novelistic sources namely the Acts of Peter and the Pseudo Clementines By the time these sources were written Simon had become the father of all heresies Accordingly virtually any heresy could be attributed to Simon As a result despite their alluring portraits of Simon these sources are mostly unusable for the historical study of the Simonian Christian movement Litwa concludes with a historical profile of the Simonian movement in the second and third centuries The book features appendices which contain Litwa s own translations of primary Simonian texts

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web the diagram below is a schematic of the prius powertrain with detail in particular i have grossly simplified the way in which the internal combustion engine ice drives the planet gears in the power split device psd and the way that the ring gear is connected to the silent chain sprocket and motor generator 2 mg2 it is

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web power split device which is a single pg in this paper in this section the basic mechanisms of a single pg and possible configurations are described for further developments in clutch placements fig 1 shows a pg and its equivalent lever diagram 15 the three nodes on the lever diagram represent the ring gear carrier

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web nov 6 2016 introduction many resources and threads exist that describe the prius power split device they correctly describe how rpms can be calculated and how torque is split but i did not find any that would correctly describe how the power is split the solution seems easy at first power is rpm multiplied by torque

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web the power split device the prius transmission includes a special gear set that toyota call the power split device psd this is an epicyclic or planetary gear similar to those used in automatic transmissions however its use in the prius is very different as i hope to explain

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
