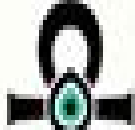


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The Visio Pauli and the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul Jan N. Bremmer, 2007 The Visio Pauli and the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul is the first modern collection of studies on the most important aspects of the Visio Pauli the most popular early Christian apocalypse in the Middle Ages The volume starts with a short study of the textual traditions of the Visio Pauli its Jewish and early Christian traditions as well as its influence on later literature such as Dante This is followed by studies of the Prologue the four rivers of Eden the place of the Ocean the relation between body and soul the image of hell and its punishments and the connection with fantastic literature Finally a codicological comparative and textual re evaluation of the Coptic translation attempts to correct earlier errors and to rehabilitate the value and interest of this long neglected version of the Visio Pauli The book is concluded with a study of the earthly tribunal in the fourth heaven of the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul As has become customary the volume is rounded off by an extensive bibliography of the Visio Pauli and the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul and a detailed index

The Apocalypse of Adam Charles W. Hedrick, 2005-09-20 The Apocalypse of Adam was discovered among the papyri from the ancient gnostic library at Nag Hammadi Egypt in 1946 It is a revelatory discourse that Adam delivers to his son Seth This discourse is the fifth and final tractate in Nag Hammadi Codex V The manuscript is now in the Coptic Museum in Old Cairo codex inv no 10548 In Part I of this significant treatment Hedrick analyzes the sources that lay behind this work the redaction and the main theological themes In Part II he provides the Coptic text translation and notes on the complete text broken down by Source A Source B and the Redactor's additions

The Nag Hammadi Library in English James James McConkey Robinson, Richard Smith, Coptic Gnostic Library Project, 1996-01-01 First published in 1978 The Nag Hammadi Library was widely acclaimed by critics and scholars alike Containing many of the writings of the Gnostics since the time of Christ this was the work that launched modern Gnostic studies and exposed a movement whose teachings are in many ways as relevant today as they were sixteen centuries ago Although some of the texts had appeared in other translations the 1978 edition was the first and only translation of these

ancient and fascinating manuscripts to appear in one volume This new edition is the result of ten years of additional research and editorial and critical work Every translation has been changed or added to many have been thoroughly revised

Unearthed in 1945 near the town of Nag Hammadi in Upper Egypt the texts literally begin where the Dead Sea Scrolls end Their discovery is seen as equally significant bringing to light a long hidden well of new information sources and insights into early Judaism and the roots of Christianity Each text is accompanied by a new and expanded introduction Also included are a revised general introduction and an afterword discussing the modern relevance of Gnosticism from Voltaire and Blake through Melville and Yeats to Jack Kerouac and science fiction writer Philip K Dick The translations and introductions to the Nag Hammadi texts are by members of the Coptic Gnostic Library Project which includes such scholars as Helmut Koester George McRae and Elaine Pagels
