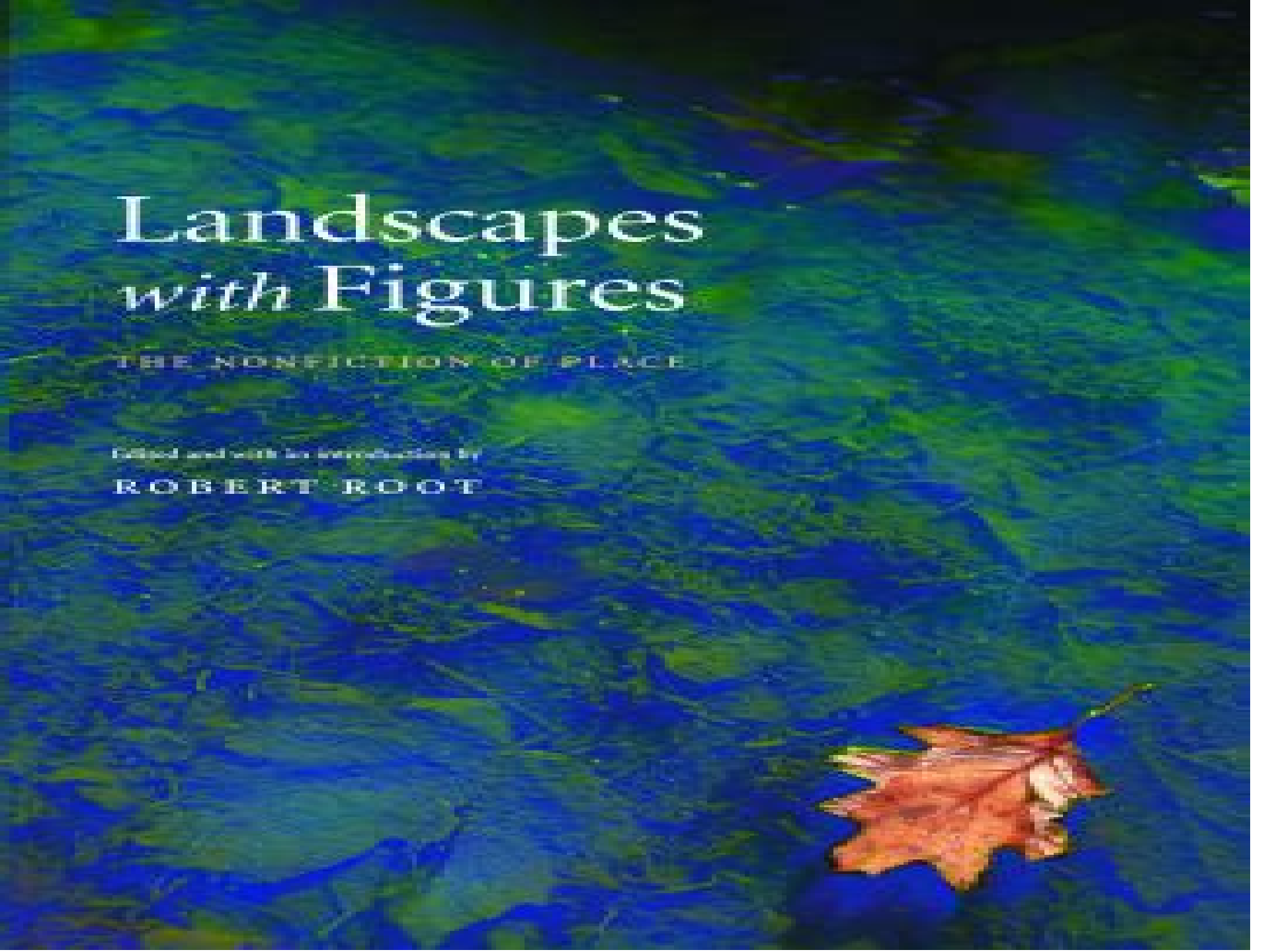

Root, 2007-04-01 For some a sense of place is about travel about plunging oneself into new settings For others it is about being and knowing home This book is a collection of essays memoirs nature writing and travel narratives that document the impact this sense of place has on writing In locations as familiar as Cape Cod or Mesa Verde and as exotic as Krakow or Kyrgyzstan thirteen accomplished writers of contemporary creative nonfiction share some of their most memorable work disclosing how place alters our perception and influences our insight Taking readers to deserts and forests islands and mountains Landscapes with Figures is an encounter not only with places but also with writers themselves Each contribution is accompanied by an author's commentary that discusses the relationship to place in his or her writing The authors reveal the connections they feel to the places they write about the role that place plays in the choices they make in relating their experiences and the strategies and work habits that produce such writing This compilation is at once a wide ranging anthology of the nonfiction of place for the armchair traveler and a book about writing for those who aspire to understand and practice the craft carrying with it the invitation to reflect on one's own special places **Region, Nature, Frontiers** Donna L. Unsworth, 2009-05-27 The book is a collection of sixteen essays on issues of regional and national identities and perceptions in literature ranging from South Africa to the United States Discussions include the American frontier the relationship between non fiction and place linguistic and postcolonial boundaries *The Solace of Stones* Julie Riddle, 2016-04 Everything changes when Julie Riddle's parents stumble across the wilderness survival guide *How to Live in the Woods on Pennies a Day* In 1977 when Riddle is seven years old she and her family fed up with the challenges of city life move to the foot of the Cabinet Mountains Wilderness in northwestern Montana For three years they live in the primitive basement of the log house they are building by hand in the harsh remote Montana woods Meanwhile haunted by the repressed memory of childhood sexual abuse Riddle struggles to come to terms with the dark shadows that plague her amid entrenched cultural and gender mores enforced by enduring myths of the West As Riddle grapples with her own painful secrets she discovers the world around her and its impact on people the demands of living in a rural mountain community dependent on boom and bust mining and logging industries the health and environmental crises of the W R Grace asbestos contamination and EPA cleanup and the healing beauty of the Montana wild More than simply a memoir about family and place *The Solace of Stones* explores Riddle's coming of age and the complexities of memory loss and identity borne by a family homesteading in the modern West **Walking in the Land of Many Gods** A. James Wohlpart, 2013 How are we placed on Earth What is our relationship to the world around us and how does our thinking affect the way we relate to the world We are entrapped says A James Wohlpart by what Martin Heidegger calls enframing a worldview that considers all objects as mere resources for our use *Walking in the Land of Many Gods* envisions a new way of thinking about the world one grounded in a moral imagination reconnected to Earth Insightful readings of three contemporary classics of nature writing

Janisse Ray's *Ecology of a Cracker Childhood* Terry Tempest Williams's *Refuge: An Unnatural History of Family and Place* and Linda Hogan's *Dwellings: A Spiritual History of the Living World* are at the heart of Wohlpart's endeavor. Powerful and affecting works like these reveal a pathway to a deeper remembering one that reconnects us with the primal forces of creation and acknowledges the sacredness of the world. We have forgotten that the world around us is rich and fertile and generative, says Wohlpart. His exploration of these literary works based on deep anthropology and Native American philosophy opens a pathway into a new way of thinking called sacred reason. Founded on interdependence and interrelationship and on care and compassion, sacred reason reminds us that divinity exists around us at all times. We are invited to walk once again in a land filled with many gods.

[Following Isabella](#) Robert Root, 2011-12-07 A world traveler Isabella Bird recorded her 1873 visit to Colorado Territory in her classic travel narrative *A Lady's Life in the Rocky Mountains*. This work inspired Robert Root's own discovery of Colorado's Front Range following his move from the flatlands of Michigan. In this elegantly written book, Root retraces Bird's three-month journey seeking to understand what Colorado meant to her and what it would come to mean for him. *Following Isabella* is a work of intersecting histories. Root interweaves an overview of Bird's life and work with regional history, nature writing, and his own travels to produce a uniquely informative and entertaining narrative. He probes Bird's self-transformation as her writing moved from private letters to published books and also draws on reflections of other authors of her day, including Grace Greenwood and Helen Hunt Jackson. Like Bird, Root experiences his most fulfilling moments in the mountains, climbing formidable Longs Peak, living alone in the cabin of famed editor William Allen White, and wandering wild landscapes. Through reflections on earlier writers' experiences and by weighing his own response to them, Root learns not only how to come to Colorado as visitors so often do, but more important, how to stay.

Home and Nation in Anglophone Autobiographies of Africa Lena Englund, 2023-10-21 This book looks at contemporary autobiographical works by writers with African backgrounds in relation to the idea of place It examines eight authors works Helen Cooper's *The House at Sugar Beach* Sisonke Msimang's *Always Another Country* Leila Ahmed's *A Border Passage* Noo Saro Wiwa's *Looking for Transwonderland* Douglas Rogers's *The Last Resort* Elamin Abdelmahmoud's *Son of Elsewhere* Clemantine Wamariya and Elizabeth Weil's *The Girl Who Smiled Beads* and Aminatta Forna's autobiographical writing to argue that place is particularly central to personal narrative in texts whose authors have migrated multiple times Spanning Liberia Nigeria Sierra Leone Egypt Rwanda Zambia and Zimbabwe this book interrogates the label African writing which has been criticized for ignoring local contexts It demonstrates how in their works these writers seek to reconnect with a bygone Africa often after complex experiences of political upheavals and personal loss The chapters also provide in depth analyses of key concepts related to place and autobiography place and privilege place and trauma and the relationship between place and nation

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
