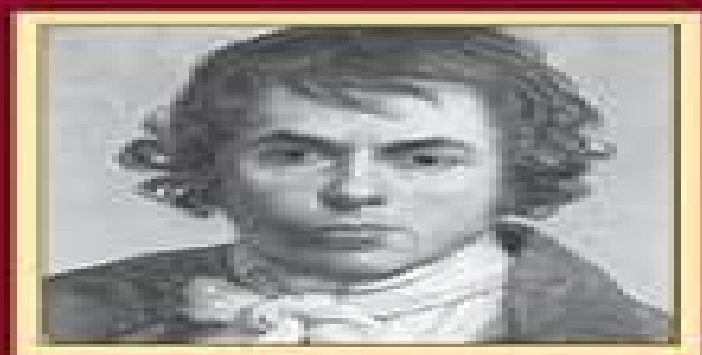

encouraged scientific productivity on the eve of the Revolution In the present monumental and elegantly written sequel to that work which Princeton is reissuing concurrently he examines how the revolutionary and Napoleonic context contributed to modernization both of politics and science In politics argues Gillispie the central feature of this modernization was conversion of subjects of a monarchy into citizens of a republic in direct contact with a state enormously augmented in power To the scientific community attainment of professional status was what citizenship was to all Frenchmen in the republic proper namely the license to self governance and dignity within the respective contexts Revolutionary circumstances set up a resonance between politics and science since practitioners of both were future oriented in their outlook and scornful of the past Among the creations of the First French Republic were institutions providing the earliest higher education in science From them emerged rigorously trained people who constituted the founding generation in the disciplines of mathematical physics positivistic biology and clinical medicine That scientists were able to achieve their ends was owing to the expertise they provided the revolutionary and imperial authorities in education medicine warfare empire building and industrial technology

answers to how and why this addiction crisis transpired over two hundred years of long development this Brief examines the role that the chemistry laboratory played in turning patients into consumers By utilizing a host of diverse sources this Brief seeks to trace the design and the production of opioids and their antecedents over the past two centuries From the isolation and development of the first alkaloids with morphine that relieved pain within the home and on the battlefield to the widespread use of nostrums and the addiction crisis that ensued to the dissemination of drugs by what became known as Big Pharma after the World Wars and finally to competition from home made pharmaceuticals the progenitor was always in some form a type of chemistry lab At times the laboratory pressed science to think deeply about society s maladies such as curing disease and alleviating pain in order to look for new opportunities in the name of progress Despite the best intentions opioids have created a paradox of pain as they were manipulated by creating relief with synthetic precision and influencing a dystopian vision Thus influence came in many forms from governments from the medical community and from the entrepreneurial aspirations of the general populace For better but mostly for worse all played a role in changing forever the trajectory of what started with the isolation of a compound in Germany Combining chemistry and history in a rousing new long form narrative that even broadens the definition of a laboratory the origins and future of this complicated topic are carefully examined

Oliver,2018-06-18 Jean Baptiste Pierre LeBrun s life was marked by his intense interest in art first as an artist and then from 1770 until his death in 1813 as an art dealer connoisseur and as a participant in the transformation of the Louvre into a national museum during the French Revolution He managed to accommodate whichever regime assumed power from monarchy to republic to empire He married the artist Elisabeth Vig e in 1776 and together they figured prominently in the pre revolutionary cultural world of Paris LeBrun travelled widely buying art for his gallery and contributing to a number of aristocratic collections His expertise in attributions of 17th century Dutch and Flemish paintings was acknowledged internationally while his reference work on the subject was considered the most

comprehensive ever written LeBrun the grand nephew of the illustrious artist Charles LeBrun became one of the most successful art dealers in Paris He played an active role in the politics of art between 1789 and 1802 serving as an expert commissioner in restoration at the national museum His inventories of artworks confiscated from all over Europe by Napoleon s armies have provided a valuable record of the development of the French national museum In addition his inventories have been useful in the identification and recovery of Nazi confiscations during World War II LeBrun s accomplishments during a tumultuous period of political and artistic change present evidence of his contributions to the concept of the modern art museum notably in the areas of conservation restoration and arrangement **Historical**
