Mailed Fist Ken Ford,2005-01-01 Formed in 1940 the British 6th Armoured Division was in the thick of the action in North Africa from December 1942 in the climactic encounters with the Deutsches Afrika Korps Combining eye witness accounts unit war diaries and unpublished sources this is a history of this distinguished division *British Armoured Divisions and Their Commanders, 1939-1945* Richard Doherty,2013-07-16 A total of eleven British armoured divisions were formed during the 1939 1945 war but as this highly informative book reveals just eight saw action In 1940 only 1st Armoured Division faced the German blitzkrieg and it was in the North African desert that armoured divisions came into their own The terrain was ideal and six such divisions of Eighth Army fought Rommel s Panzers into submission Three were disbanded prior to the invasion of Sicily and Italy The campaign from D Day onwards saw the Guards Armoured 7th Armoured the Desert Rats 11th and Percy Hobart s 79th Armoured Division in the thick of the action Of particular interest are the men who commanded these elite formations and the way their characters contributed to the outcome of operations While some such as Dick McCreery went onto greater heights others did not make the grade the stakes were high A number such as Pip Roberts were just perfectly suited in the role Written by a leading military historian this book describes many fascinating aspects of armoured warfare from its uncertain beginnings through the development of tactics and the evolving tank design Due to British deficiencies reliance had to be placed on US Grants and Shermans with the Comet coming late and the Centurion too late The combination of gripping historical narrative and well researched fact make this an invaluable and highly readable work on the contribution of British Armoured Divisions to victory in the Second World War *The Second World War Through Soldiers' Eyes* James Goulty,2016-07-31 What was it really like to serve in the British Army during the Second World War Discover a soldier s view of life in the British Army from recruitment and training to the brutal realities of combat Using first hand sources James Goulty reconstructs the experiences of the men and women who made up the citizen s army Find out about the weapons and equipment they used the uniforms they wore how they adjusted to army discipline and faced the challenges of active service overseas What happened when things went wrong What were your chances of survival if you were injured in combat or taken prisoner While they didn t go into combat thousands of women also served in the British Army with the ATS or as nurses What were their wartime lives like And when the war had finally ended how did newly demobilised soldiers and servicewomen cope with returning home The British Army that emerged victorious in 1945 was vastly different from the poorly funded force of 865 000 men who heard Neville Chamberlain declare war in 1939 With an influx of civilian volunteers and conscripts the army became a citizens force and its character and size were transformed By D Day Britain had a well equipped disciplined army of over three million men and women and during the war they served in a diverse range of places across the world This book uncovers some of their stories and gives a fascinating insight into the realities of army life in wartime **Royal Artillery in the Second World War** Richard Doherty,2016-07-22 During the

Eighth Army in Italy, 1943-45 Richard Doherty,2007-10-18 Eighth Army Britain s most famous field army of the twentieth century landed in Italy in September 1943 and fought continuously until the defeat of the Germans in early May 1945 This book studies the experience of Eighth Army in the Italian campaign examining how a force accustomed to the open spaces of North Africa adjusted to the difficult terrain of Italy where fighting became much more a matter for the infantry than for the armour It also compares the qualities of the commanders of Eighth Army in Italy Montgomery Leese and finally McCreery The book uses official records at various levels personal accounts some never before published and published material to present a picture of an army that although defined as British was one of the war s most cosmopolitan formations Its soldiers came from the UK Canada India Ireland Nepal New Zealand Poland and South Africa as well as from Palestine the Jewish Brigade and from Italy itself **Cheer Up, Mate!** Alan Weeks,2011-10-03 Cheer Up Mate is a compilation of comical tales and anecdotes from World War Two Between 1939 and 1945 the world witnessed what is generally agreed to be the most horrific war in history Millions died and millions more were physically or psychologically wounded by the conflict

Yet amidst the pain and devastation people were not only able to survive they also managed to maintain a sense of humour For some it was precisely this ability to laugh at their misfortunes and those of the other side that enabled them to soldier on This was especially true of the British a nation whose reaction to more or less anything up to and including someone's house being bombed to rubble tended to be never mind have a cup of tea This Blitz Spirit is perhaps best summed up by Mona Lott one of the characters in Tommy Handley's radio show It's That Man Again the show's title itself being a comical reference to Hitler it's being so cheerful as keeps me going In this collection of stories which covers the armed forces and civilians from both sides Alan Weeks demonstrates how humour can survive even in the most unlikely of circumstances *The Royal Corps of Signals* Cliff Lord, Graham Watson, 2014-02-24 The ability to communicate is a prerequisite for success both in military and civil life Surprisingly everyone expects access to communications but rarely wonders how it is achieved The purpose of this book is to bring into focus one of the cornerstones of the success of the British Army and to provide an insight into the complexity and diversity of the Royal Corps of Signals This is done not by narrative but by delving into unit history rather than campaign history thus offering a different perspective for the historian Royal Signals is one of the largest Corps in the British Army and consists of a body of very highly trained and dedicated personnel to manage operate and repair the advanced technology that is theirs to administer Signals are the Invisible Elite without them there is no victory Before the independent Corps of Signals was formed in 1920 Royal Engineers provided communications for much of the Army Details of their signal units are included Reflecting the new technologies as they occur the reader will see the new signal units being raised to facilitate the exigencies of the time For example during the Second World War the Golden Arrow Detachments were created as independent mobile high speed transmitting and receiving stations to provide links to Britain and thus provide High Command with the information from Commanders in the Field that was desperately needed These units also passed intercepted enemy signals back to England for the code breakers at Bletchley Park Other specialist Signal units were created for Air Support Para Signals Commandos Interception Fixed Communications Peacekeeping and a multitude of other reasons In today's changing world signals continue to get their message through Swift and Sure This book is a must for historians genealogists and those that served It contains Overviews of the Signals Order of Battle at specific times in history Detailed profiles of specialist signal units including Commando and Para units History of 35 Commonwealth and related Signal Corps Photographs of many rare signal badges Scores and scores of unit histories both Regular and Territorial from the past to the present *Companion to the British Army 1939-45* Lieutenant Colonel George Forty OBE, 2009-10-01 To encapsulate the British Army in one book is no easy task but here George Forty presents it as it was during the Second World War When war was declared in 1939 the British Army was very much the Cinderella of the three armed services with a total strength of around 865 000 men However just four years later when the Allies invaded north west Europe the British Army had grown into a powerful well organised and well equipped fighting force of 3 million men and women George Forty presents a
