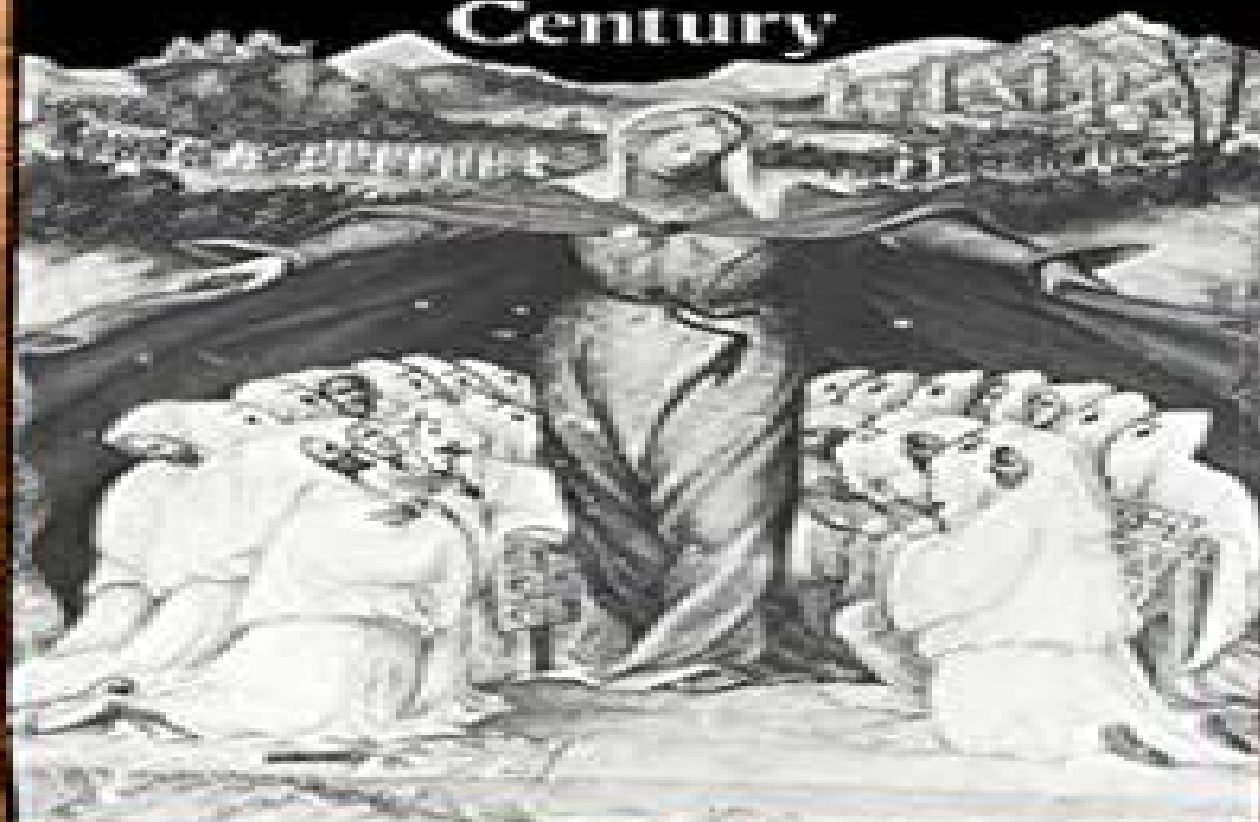

Black, 1989-06-15 Confraternities were and are religious brotherhoods for lay people to promote their religious life in common Though designed to prepare for the afterlife they were fully involved in the social political and cultural life of the community and could affect all men and women as members or as the recipients of charity Confraternities organised a great range of devotional cultural and indeed artistic activities in addition to other functions such as the provision of dowries and the escort of condemned men to the scaffold Other works have studied the local activities of specific confraternities but this is the first to attempt a broad survey of such organisations across the breadth of early modern Italy Christopher Black demonstrates clearly the extent diversity and influence of confraternal behaviour and shows how such brotherhoods adapted to the religious and social crises of the sixteenth century thus illuminating current debates about Catholic Reform the Counter Reformation poverty philanthropy and social control

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Mary of Mercy in Medieval and Renaissance Italian Art Katherine T. Brown, 2017-07-05 Mater Misericordiae Mother of Mercy emerged as one of the most prolific subjects in central Italian art from the late thirteenth through the sixteenth centuries With iconographic origins in Marian cult relics brought from Palestine to Constantinople in the fifth century the amalgam of attributes coalesced in Armenian Cilicia then morphed as it spread to Cyprus An early concept of Mary of Mercy the Virgin standing with outstretched arms and a wide mantle under which kneel or stand devotees entered the Italian peninsula at the ports of Bari and Venice during the Crusades eventually converging in central Italy The mendicant orders adopted the image as an easily recognizable symbol for mercy and aided in its diffusion In this study the author's primary goals are to explore the iconographic origins of the Madonna della Misericordia as a devotional image by identifying and analyzing key attributes to consider circumstances for its eventual overlapping function as a secular symbol used by lay confraternities and to discuss its diaspora throughout the Italian peninsula Western Europe and eastward into Russia and Ukraine With over 100 illustrations the book presents an array of works of art as examples including altarpieces frescoes oil

paintings manuscript illuminations metallurgy glazed terracotta stained glass architectural relief sculpture and processional banners

Women and Poor Relief in Seventeenth-Century France Susan E. Dinan, 2017-09-29 Chronicling the history of the Daughters of Charity through the seventeenth century this study examines how the community's existence outside of convents helped to change the nature of women's religious communities and the early modern Catholic church Unusually for the time this group of Catholic religious women remained uncloistered They lived in private houses in the cities and towns of France offering medical care religious instruction and alms to the sick and the poor by the end of the century they were France's premier organization of nurses This book places the Daughters of Charity within the context of early modern poor relief in France the author shows how they played a critical role in shaping the system and also how they were shaped by it The study also examines the complicated relationship of the Daughters of Charity to the Catholic church of the time analyzing it not only for what light it can shed on the history of the community but also for what it can tell us about the Catholic Reformation more generally

Heresy, Culture, and Religion in Early Modern Italy Ronald K. Delph, Michelle M. Fontaine, John Jeffries Martin, 2006-09-01 Leading scholars from Italy and the United States offer a fresh and nuanced image of the religious reform movements on the Italian peninsula in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries United in their conviction that religious ideas can only be fully understood in relation to the particular social cultural and political contexts in which they develop these scholars explore a wide range of protagonists from popes bishops and inquisitors to humanists and merchants to artists jewelers and nuns What emerges is a story of negotiations mediations compromises and of shifting boundaries between heresy and orthodoxy This book is essential reading for all students of the history of Christianity in early modern Europe

Tortured Subjects Lisa Silverman, 2010-06-15 At one time in Europe there was a point to pain physical suffering could be a path to redemption This religious notion suggested that truth was lodged in the body and could be achieved through torture In *Tortured Subjects* Lisa Silverman tells the haunting story of how this idea became a fixed part of the French legal system during the early modern period Looking closely at the theory and practice of judicial torture in France from 1600 to 1788 the year in which it was formally abolished Silverman revisits dossiers compiled in criminal cases including transcripts of interrogations conducted under torture as well as the writings of physicians and surgeons concerned with the problem of pain records of religious confraternities diaries and letters of witnesses to public executions and the writings of torture's abolitionists and apologists She contends that torture was at the center of an epistemological crisis that forced French jurists and intellectuals to reconsider the relationship between coercion and sincerity or between free will and evidence As the philosophical consensus on which torture rested broke down and definitions of truth and pain shifted so too did the foundation of torture until by the eighteenth century it became an indefensible practice

Abandoned Children of the Italian Renaissance Nicholas Terpstra, 2020-04-07 In the early development of the modern Italian state individual orphanages were a reflection of the intertwining of politics and charity Nearly half of the children who lived in the cities of

the late Italian Renaissance were under fifteen years of age Grinding poverty unstable families and the death of a parent could make caring for these young children a burden Many were abandoned others orphaned At a time when political rulers fashioned themselves as the fathers of society these cast off children presented a very immediate challenge and opportunity In Bologna and Florence government and private institutions pioneered orphanages to care for the growing number of homeless children Nicholas Terpstra discusses the founding and management of these institutions the procedures for placing children into them the children s daily routine and education and finally their departure from these homes He explores the role of the city state and considers why Bologna and Florence took different paths in operating the orphanages Terpstra finds that Bologna s orphanages were better run looked after the children more effectively and were more successful in returning their wards to society as productive members of the city s economy Florence s orphanages were larger and harsher and made little attempt to reintegrate children into society Based on extensive archival research and individual stories

The Art of Executing Well Nicholas Terpstra,2008-10-01 In Renaissance Italy a good execution was both public and peaceful at least in the eyes of authorities In a feature unique to Italy the people who prepared a condemned man or woman spiritually and psychologically for execution were not priests or friars but laymen This volume includes some of the songs stories poems and images that they used together with first person accounts and ballads describing particular executions Leading scholars expand on these accounts explaining aspects of the theater psychology and politics of execution

The main text is a manual translated in English for the first time on how to comfort a man in his last hours before beheading or hanging. It became an influential text used across Renaissance Italy. A second lengthy piece gives an eyewitness account of the final hours of two patrician Florentines executed for conspiracy against the Medici in 1512. Shorter pieces include poems written by prisoners on the eve of their execution, songs sung by the condemned and their comforters, and popular broadsheets reporting on particular executions. It is richly illustrated with the small panel paintings that were thrust into prisoners' faces to distract them as they made the public journey to the gallows. Six interdisciplinary essays explain the contexts and meanings of these writings and of execution rituals generally. They explore the relation of execution rituals to late medieval street theater, the use of art to comfort the condemned, the literature that issued from prisons by the hands of condemned prisoners, the theological issues around public executions in the Renaissance, the psychological dimensions of the comforting process, and some of the social, political, and historical dimensions of executions and comforting in Renaissance Italy.

The Sacralization of Space and Behavior in the Early Modern World Jennifer Mara DeSilva, 2016-03-09 In the Early Modern period, as both reformed and Catholic churches strove to articulate orthodox belief and conduct through texts, sermons, rituals, and images, communities grappled frequently with the connection between sacred space and behavior. *The Sacralization of Space and Behavior in the Early Modern World* explores individual and community involvement in the approbation, reconfiguration, and regulation of sacred spaces and the behavior both animal and human within them. The individual's understanding of sacred space and consequently the behavior appropriate within it depended on local need, group dynamics, and the dissemination of normative expectations. While these expectations were defined in a growing body of confessionalizing literature locally and internationally, traditional clerical authorities found their decisions contested, circumvented, or elaborated in order to make room for other stakeholders' activities and needs. To clearly reveal the efforts of early modern groups to negotiate authority and the transformation of behavior with sacred space, this collection presents examples that allow the deconstruction of these tensions and the exploration of the resulting campaigns within sacred space. Based on new archival research, the eleven chapters in this collection examine diverse aspects of the campaigns to transform Christian behavior within a variety of types of sacred space and through a spectrum of media. These essays give voice to the arguments, exhortations, and accusations that surrounded the activities taking place in early modern sacred space and reveal much about how people made sense of these transformations.

Kiddy,2007-03-30 Blacks of the Rosary tells the story of the Afro Brazilian communities that developed within lay religious brotherhoods dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary in Minas Gerais It shows how these brotherhoods functioned as a social space in which Africans and their descendants could rebuild a communal identity based on a shared history of an African past and an ongoing devotional practice thereby giving rise to enduring transnational cultures that have survived to the present day In exploring this intersection of community identity and memory the book probes the Portuguese and African contributions to the brotherhoods in Part One Part Two traces the changes and continuities within the organizations from the early eighteenth century to the end of the Brazilian Empire and the book concludes in Part Three with discussion of the twentieth century brotherhoods and narratives of the participants in brotherhood festivals in the 1990s In a larger sense the book serves as a case study through which readers can examine the strategies that Afro Brazilians used to create viable communities in order to confront the asymmetry of power inherent in the slave societies of the Americas and their economic and social marginalization in the twentieth century History of Catholic Theological Ethics, A Keenan, James F., SJ,2022
