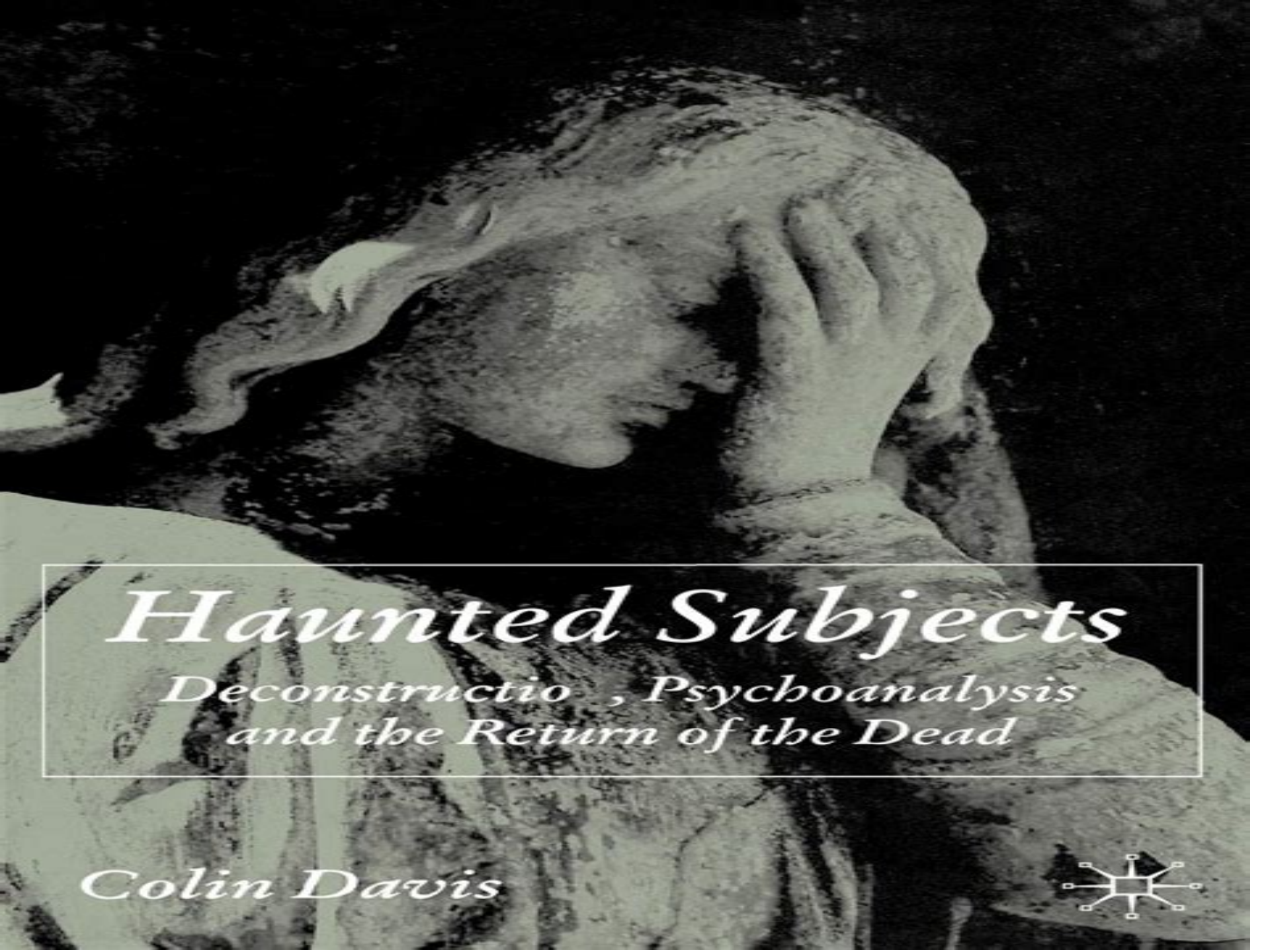

The Theological Turn in Contemporary Gothic Fiction Simon Marsden, 2018-09-21 This study examines theological themes and resonances in post 1970 Gothic fiction It argues that contemporary Gothic is not simply a secularised genre but rather one that engages creatively and often subversively with theological texts and traditions This creative engagement is reflected in Gothic fiction's exploration of theological concepts including sin and evil Christology and the messianic resurrection eschatology and apocalypse Through readings of fiction by Gothic and horror writers including Stephen King Joyce Carol Oates Peter Straub William Peter Blatty and others this book demonstrates that Christianity continues to haunt the Gothic imagination and that the genre's openness to the mysterious numinous and non rational opens space in which to explore religious beliefs and experiences less easily accessible to more overtly realist forms of representation The book offers a new perspective on contemporary Gothic fiction that will be of interest to students and scholars of contemporary Gothic and of the relationship between literature and religion more generally

French Orientalist Literature in Algeria, 1845-1882 Sage Goellner, 2018-03-06 This book applies the growing theoretical field of hauntology to a body of literature which has previously been examined through the lenses of Orientalism and exoticism Through a chronological study and close readings of the writings of Thophile Gautier Eugène Fromentin Gustave Flaubert and Pierre Loti the project identifies haunting echoes within the texts which demonstrate an ambivalence of attitudes towards colonialism and which undermine any claim towards a monolithic imperialist French ideology Whereas hauntological theory has been used to illuminate literature from the Francophone post colonial period it has not yet been applied to texts produced during the French colonial period The originality of this project thus lies in the application of Derridean hauntological theory to works from an earlier period each of which in one way or another addresses the theme of colonial violence By revisiting four classic works of colonial Orientalism with haunting as a principal theme this analysis provides a

critical witnessing of France's violent colonization of Algeria that demonstrates France's latent anxieties about the colonial project at the time

The Modern Supernatural and the Beginnings of Cinema Murray Leeder, 2017-01-10 This study sees the nineteenth century supernatural as a significant context for cinema's first years The book takes up the familiar notion of cinema as a ghostly spectral or haunted medium and asks what made such association possible Examining the history of the projected image and supernatural displays psychical research and telepathy spirit photography and X rays the skeletons of the danse macabre and the ghostly spaces of the mind it uncovers many lost and fascinating connections The Modern Supernatural and the Beginnings of Cinema locates film's spectral affinities within a history stretching back to the beginning of screen practice and forward to the digital era In addition to examining the use of supernatural themes by pioneering filmmakers like Georges Méliès and George Albert Smith it also engages with the representations of cinema's ghostly past in Guy Maddin's recent online project Seances 2016 It is ideal for those interested in the history of cinema the study of the supernatural and the pre history of the horror film

Breaking the Silence Merilyn Moos, 2015-02-04 There has been extensive research into the impact of the Holocaust on the children of survivors who immigrated to the US and Israel But very little work in this space has looked at children whose parents fled Nazi persecution before the Holocaust Even less attention has been paid to those who ended up in Britain from Germany Austria Czechoslovakia and Hungary What was the impact on this second generation How have the lives of these ordinary people been shaped by their parents' dislocation Using a series of interviews with members of the second generation *Breaking the Silence* is a qualitative interdisciplinary exploration how their lives were shaped by their parents' escape from persecution It offers an insight into how the exile and fear of persecution of the parents and the deaths/murder of unknown relatives has left this generation both bereft of memories and haunted by the past
