In 1985, a Georgia Association of Historians survey ranked Arnall's leadership, responsiveness to issues, and national reputation the highest among governors who served from 1943-1983. Successful as it was, his career began a decade earlier in the state house of representatives, where it was cut short. Many Georgians felt that Arnall was too liberal and worse, that he had catered to the national media, enhancing his own image by discussing the state's problems with outsiders. By Arnall's own estimation, his political career ended when he decided to abide by a 1945 federal court decision that invalidated Georgia's white voters-only primary elections. Arnall left politics in 1947, returning briefly in 1966 for a spirited but unsuccessful primary bid for governor. Finley's *From Slavery to Segregation* explores the key features shaping southern politics during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries as explained in the South's defense of its racial systems It treats slavery and segregation as part of the same whole rather than as discrete institutions rooted in different periods In the process the book uncovers the deep historical origins of the region's states rights philosophy and the unfortunate persistence of a culture dominated by calls for white supremacy While highlighting the broad overview of southern racial and political thought Finley underscores the larger American struggle with racial injustice which although most pronounced in the South afflicted the entire nation The South's defense of chattel slavery became a natural model for the region's defense of segregation during the Jim Crow era Through a comparative analysis of the rhetoric employed in the justification of both racial institutions Finley reveals elements of continuity and change in the region's identity Ultimately he shows how the history of the twentieth century South is irreparably linked to the century before it For instance one cannot understand the ferocity of resistance to the Supreme Court's 1954 *Brown v Board* decision without being aware of how and why the South emerged as it did after the Civil War The Old South and the New South shared a similar constellation of ideas that informed arguments advancing their respective race based social orders which took the form of a commonality of perception regarding race a sense of being assailed by outsiders and a series of appeals to the highest secular authority in the pantheon of regional and American beliefs the Constitution Discontinuity however marked the long term strategies of both the prewar and postwar South Although segregationists sought to preserve the racial status quo as did their forebears they ultimately relented when confronted with federal power and grudgingly shifted toward a narrative that less often foregrounded race when championing states rights

Red Pepper and Gorgeous George James C. Clark, 2011-10-09 For nearly a century in Florida and throughout the South election to the United States Senate virtually guaranteed a lifetime position especially if you were a Democrat Certainly no Republican candidate stood a chance in the general election and it was nearly unthinkable to imagine a serious challenger emerging in the primary Claude Red Pepper first ran for the U S Senate in 1934 Though unsuccessful despite allegations of voter fraud he won a special election two years later after both senators from Florida died in office Reelected to full terms in 1938 and 1944 as a vigorous supporter of the New Deal he had every reason to suspect the seat was his indefinitely or at least until he decided it was time to seek higher office Pepper saw himself as the national heir to Roosevelt s foreign policy he encouraged cooperation with the Soviet Union our World War II ally and actively worked to defeat Truman s presidential nomination in 1948 After nearly fourteen years in office Pepper had earned the enmity of the president alienated most of his colleagues in the senate and aligned himself with the ultra left wing politics of Henry Wallace Still in the entire history of the state no sitting Florida Senator had ever been voted out of office However the political world was changing and it was the right leaning Gorgeous George Smathers not Pepper who recognized and took advantage of this fact Smathers fought a vicious bare knuckled campaign employing ferocious and divisive attacks against Pepper He helped make liberal anathema to aspiring southern politics and was the first of a new breed of conservative politicians though not yet Republican to rise to power Eventually the era would be named for a junior senator from Wisconsin but it was Smathers who first successfully employed the strategies of McCarthyism to unseat an incumbent He was so successful in fact that before the general election Smathers had to reassure President Truman and other potential supporters that his loyalties did in fact lie with the Democratic Party His resounding victory inspired others including Richard Nixon and Barry Goldwater to adopt similar tactics in their senatorial campaigns It also helped set the stage for the complete reversal of the political power structure that had ruled the South since the end of Reconstruction *Red Pepper and Gorgeous George* is a fascinating look at the campaign that changed everything in Florida and the South It is also a shocking sobering reminder that despite introducing the phrase hanging chad to the national lexicon the 2000 presidential election was merely the second most important national election to take place in the state
