Jacob's Ladder Sergius Bulgakov, 2010-11-16 Few of Sergius Bulgakov's professional writings achieve the lyrical heights of Jacob's Ladder In it he discusses the doctrine of angels and their importance for contemporary humanity He includes reflections on the meaning of love the sexes death and the Christian hope of resurrection meditating on the Wisdom of God in the creation This work completes the word picture of divinized and Sophianic creation begun in The Burning Bush and The Friend of the Bridegroom which together constitute what scholars call Bulgakov's major or first trilogy **Jacob's Ladder** Sergii Bulgakov, 2014 Few of the great Russian author Sergius Bulgakov's writings achieve the lyrical heights of Jacob's Ladder In this book originally published in 1929 Bulgakov explores the doctrine of angels and their importance for contemporary humanity He frames his work with meditations on the meaning of love not as a sentimental indulgence but as a way of understanding the deep tender self sacrificing personal knowledge that is both at the heart of a Trinitarian God and in the midst of relationships between human beings and their guardian angels These discussions on the creation function nature appearances and incorporeality of angels lead also to reflections on the incarnation and human nature especially the role of the sexes death and the Christian hope of resurrection Jacob's Ladder completes the development of Divine Sophia on the Wisdom of God in creation begun in The Burning Bush and The Friend of the Bridegroom which together constitute Bulgakov's first dogmatic trilogy **Ascending Jacob's Ladder** Ronald H. Like Angels on Jacob's Ladder Harvey J. Hames, 2012-02-01 This book explores the career of Abraham Abulafia ca 1240-1291 self proclaimed Messiah and founder of the school of ecstatic Kabbalah Active in southern Italy and Sicily where Franciscans had adopted the apocalyptic teachings of Joachim of Fiore Abulafia believed the end of days was approaching and saw himself as chosen by God to reveal the Divine truth He appropriated Joachite ideas fusing them with his own revelations to create an apocalyptic and messianic scenario that he was certain would attract his Jewish contemporaries and hoped would also convince Christians From his focus on the centrality of the Tetragrammaton the four letter ineffable Divine

name to the date of the expected redemption in 1290 and the coming together of Jews and Gentiles in the inclusiveness of the new age Abulafia's engagement with the apocalyptic teachings of some of his Franciscan contemporaries enriched his own worldview Though his messianic claims were a result of his revelatory experiences and hermeneutical reading of the Torah they were to no small extent dependent on his historical circumstances and acculturation **Tarshish** Bruce

Patterson,2012-07-19 Not for the timid not for the weak fishers of men only need apply Must be able to carry a contiguous line of thought For directions to Tarshish follow the sign of the infinitive Commentary on Midrash Rabba in the Sixteenth Century Benjamin Williams,2016-09-08 Printed editions of midrashim rabbinic expositions of the Bible flooded the market for Hebrew books in the sixteenth century First published by Iberian immigrants to the Ottoman Empire they were later reprinted in large numbers at the famous Hebrew presses of Venice This study seeks to shed light on who read these new books and how they did so by turning to the many commentaries on midrash written during the sixteenth century These innovative works reveal how their authors studied rabbinic Bible interpretation and how they anticipated their readers would do so Benjamin Williams focuses particularly on the work of Abraham ben Asher of Safed the Or ha Sekhel Venice 1567 an elucidation of midrash Genesis Rabba which contains both the author's own interpretations and also the commentary he mistakenly attributed to the most celebrated medieval commentator Rashi Williams examines what is known of Abraham ben Asher's life his place among the Jewish scholars of Safed and the publication of his book in Venice By analysing selected passages of his commentary this study assesses how he shed light on rabbinic interpretation of Genesis and guided readers to correct interpretations of the words of the sages A consideration of why Abraham ben Asher published a commentary attributed to Rashi shows that he sought to lend authority to his programme of studying midrash by including interpretations ascribed to the most famous commentator alongside his own By analysing the production and reception of the Or ha Sekhel therefore this work illuminates the popularity of midrash in the early modern period and the origins of a practice which is now well established the study of rabbinic Bible interpretation with the guidance of commentaries *Works Not Hitherto Published* Thomas Taylor,1653 **Enochim** David Kendal Jones,2014-09-29 David is a Chartered Surveyor who was born

Water from Stone Jeffrey Greene,2008-04-16 Award winning author Jeffrey Greene provides a portrait by turns lyrical and provocative of J David Bamberger's unlikely transformation from first a vacuum cleaner salesman then to co founder and CEO of Church's Fried Chicken to an internationally recognized conservationist In fact Greene tells two integrally related stories the evolution of one man's business sense applying profit incentives to land restoration and nature conservancy and the creation of a Texas Hill Country preserve where he effectively demonstrates his own principles Growing up in rural Ohio during the Great Depression and World War II Bamberger learned at an early age to shun waste grow food productively and admire the Amish for living in harmony with the land His mother taught him to love the natural world and gave him a book that would set the course for his life *Pleasant Valley* by Louis Bromfield a visionary American advocate for land restoration Inspired by his new role model Bamberger would say If I ever make money I want to do what Bromfield did After finding that financial success Bamberger bought what he describes as the sorriest piece of land in Blanco County and entered upon his decades long effort to restore the ecological balance of 5 500 acres that had been virtually destroyed by more than a century
