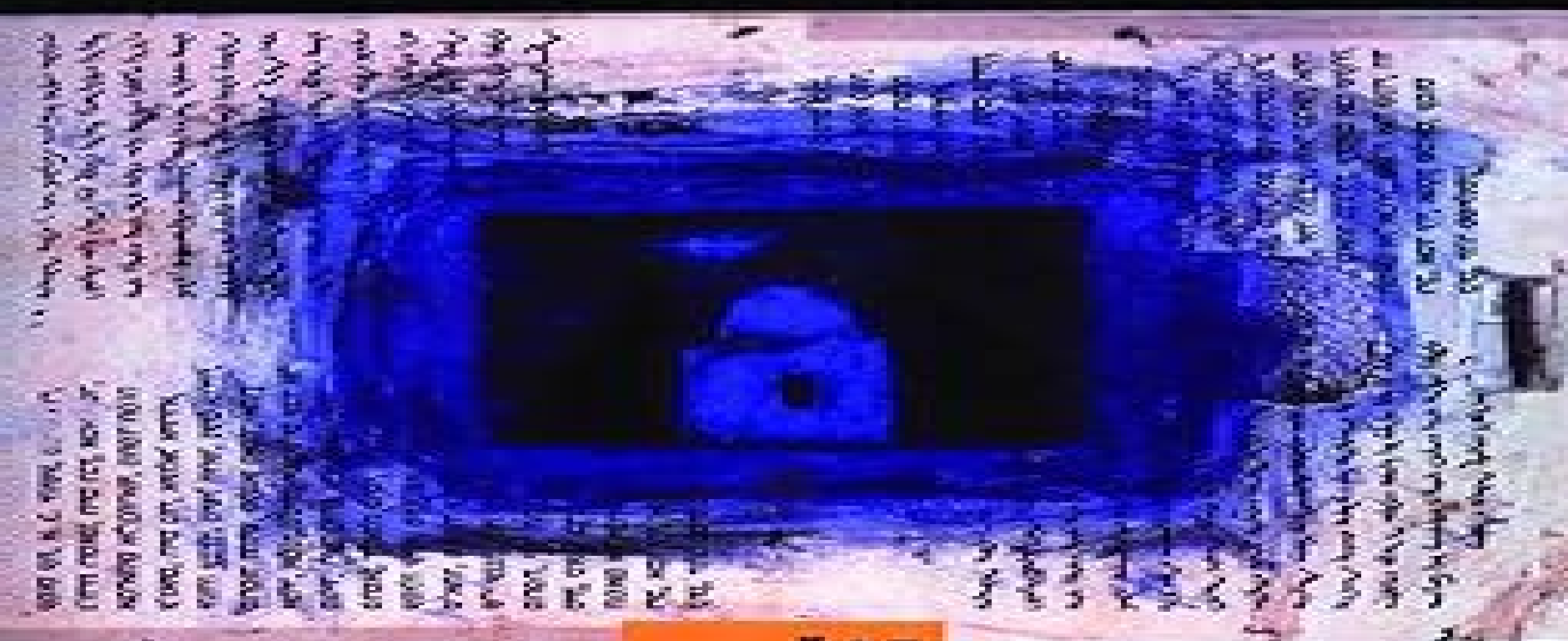

In This Place Together Penina Eilberg-Schwartz, Sulaiman Khatib, 2021-04-13 A narrative meditation on joint nonviolence opening a window to the questions of power multiple narratives and imagination that touch on struggles for justice everywhere As a Palestinian youth Sulaiman Khatib encountered the occupation in his village and attempted to fight back stabbing an Israeli Imprisoned at the age of 14 he began a process of political and spiritual transformation still unfolding today In a book he asked Penina Eilberg Schwartz an American Jew to write and based on years of conversation between them Khatib shares how his activism became deeply rooted in the belief that we must ground all work from dialogue to direct action to healing in recognition of the history and humanity of the other He reveals how he became convinced that Palestinian freedom can flourish alongside Jewish connection to the land where he was born In language that is poetic and unflinchingly honest Eilberg Schwartz and Khatib chronicle what led him to dedicate his life to joint nonviolence In his journey he encountered the deep injustice of torture witnessed the power of hunger strikes and studied Jewish history Ultimately he came to realize mutual recognition alongside a transformation of the systems that governed their lives was necessary for both Palestinians and Israelis to move forward Still as he built friendships with Israelis and resisted the occupation alongside them he could not lose sight of the great power imbalance in the relationship of all the violence and erasure still present as they dreamt forward together Intimate and political In This Place Together opens us up to the dangers and hopes of working with others across vast differences in power and experience And it opens a new space shapes a third narrative and finds another world that can exist though it's often hard to see inside this one [A Sephardi Sea](#) Dario Miccoli, 2022-07-26 A Sephardi Sea tells the story of Jews from the southern shore of the Mediterranean who between the late 1940s and the mid 1960s migrated from their country of birth for Europe Israel and beyond It is a story that explores their contrasting memories of and feelings for a Sephardi Jewish world in North Africa and Egypt that is lost forever but whose echoes many still hear Surely some of these Jewish migrants were already familiar with their new countries of residence because of colonial ties or of Zionism and often spoke the language Why then was the act of leaving so painful and why more than fifty years afterward is its memory still so tangible Dario Miccoli examines how the memories of a bygone Sephardi Mediterranean world became preserved in three national contexts Israel France and Italy where the Jews of the Middle East and North Africa and their descendants migrated and nowadays live A Sephardi Sea explores how practices of

Mehmedinovic, 2021-07-29 From one of Bosnia's most prominent poets and writers spare and haunting stories and poems that were written under the horrific circumstances of the war in Bosnia Herzegovina Semezdin Mehmedinovic remained a citizen of Sarajevo throughout the Serbian nationalists siege and was active throughout the war in the city's resistance movement as one of the editors of the magazine Phantom of Liberty Sarajevo Blues was originally published at the end of 1992 and was the first book in the Biblioteka egzil abc series published in Ljubljana which provided a forum for Bosnian writers and translators under siege or living in exile Semezdin Mehmedinovic says that writing is finally quite a personal thing that doesn't make much sense unless you are practicing for the last word For those Bosnians emerging from the siege or still in exile these last words remain intimate possessions one of the last bastions left against the commodification of tragedy Sarajevo Blues is widely considered here to be the best piece of writing to emerge from this besieged capital since Bosnia's war erupted in April 1992 Washington Post A Supreme masterpiece witnessed and redeems with total detachment I have experienced this only twice in my life with Zoran Mušić's drawings from Dachau and Semezdin Mehmedinovic's Sarajevo Blues This book will be a classic Tomaž Alamun The book for my brother Sarajevo Blues is at once a battle report and a philosophical investigation In poems micro essays and prose vignettes Semezdin Mehmedinovic charts the collapse of a world with heart breaking clarity and precision His book conveys the same clear eyes passion for the truth that one finds in the young Hemingway the Hemingway of in our time Paul Auster Book of Illusions Semezdin Mehmedinovic was born in Tuzla Bosnia in 1960 and is the author of four books In 1993 he was cowriter and codirector with Benjamin Filipović of Mizaldó one of the first Bosnian films shot during the war The film was presented at the Berlin Film Festival in 1994 and won the first prize at the Mediterranean Festival in Rome the following year He his wife and their child left Bosnia and came to the U S as political refugees in 1996 His collection of poetry Nine Alexandrias is Number 56 in the City Lights Pocket Poets Series **Mapping Jewish Identities** Laurence J. Silberstein, 2000-07 Is Jewish identity flourishing or in decline

Community leaders and scholarly researchers continually seek to determine the attitudes beliefs and activities that best measure Jewish identity At issue according to these studies is the very survival of the Jewish community itself But such studies rarely ask what actually is being examined when we attempt to assess Jewish identity or any identity Most tend to assume that identity is a preexisting relatively fixed frame of reference reflecting shared cultural and historical experiences Drawing on recent work in such fields as cultural studies poststructuralist theory postmodern philosophy and feminist theory Mapping Jewish Identities challenges this premise Contesting conventional approaches to Jewish identity contributors argue

that Jewish identity should be conceptualized as an ongoing dynamic process of becoming in response to changing cultural and social conditions rather than as a stable defining body of traits Contributors including Daniel Boyarin Laura Levitt Adi Ophir and Gordon Bearn examine such topics as American Jews desires to connect with a lost immigrant past through photography the complicated function of the Holocaust in the identity formation of contemporary Jews the impact of the struggle with the Palestinians on Israeli group identity construction and the ways in which repressed voices such as those of women Mizrahim and Israeli Arabs have changed our ways of thinking about Jewish and Israeli identity

Sephardic Jews in America Aviva Ben-Ur, 2012 A significant number of Sephardic Jews tracing their remote origins to Spain and Portugal immigrated to the United States from Turkey Greece and the Balkans from 1880 through the 1920s joined by a smaller number of Mizrahi Jews arriving from Arab lands Most Sephardim settled in New York establishing the leading Judeo Spanish community outside the Ottoman Empire With their distinct languages cultures and rituals Sephardim and Arab speaking Mizrahim were not readily recognized as Jews by their Ashkenazic coreligionists At the same time they forged alliances outside Jewish circles with Hispanics and Arabs with whom they shared significant cultural and linguistic ties The failure among Ashkenazic Jews to recognize Sephardim and Mizrahim as fellow Jews continues today More often than not these Jewish communities are simply absent from portrayals of American Jewry Drawing on primary sources such as the Ladino Judeo Spanish press archival documents and oral histories Sephardic Jews in America offers the first book length academic treatment of their history in the United States from 1654 to the present focusing on the age of mass immigration

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
