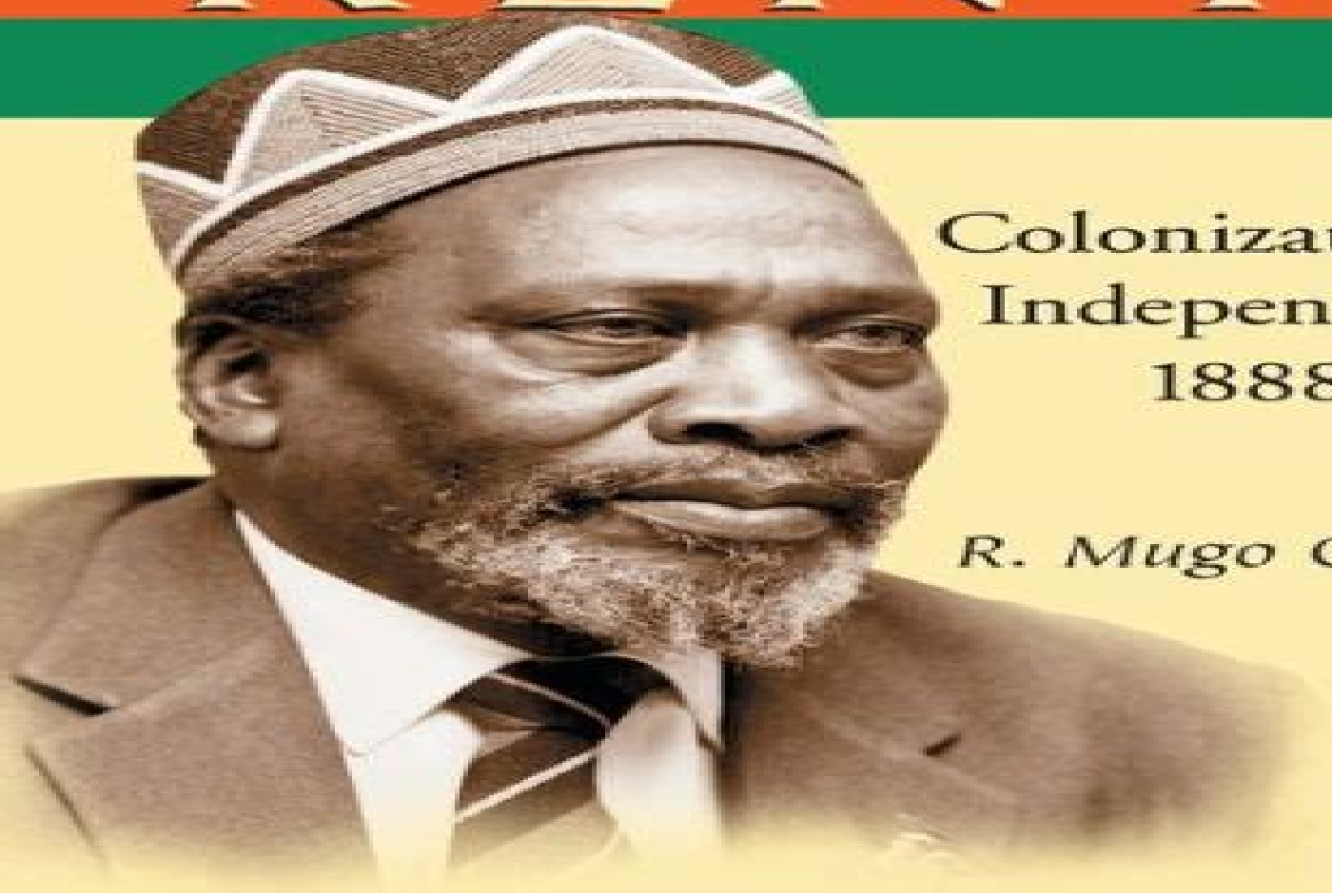

Kenya From Colonization To Independence 1888 1970:

Kenya R. Mugo Gatheru, 2005-05-31 This book relates a series of events leading from Kenya's colonization through its emergence as an independent country. Beginning with the advent of Europeans in the late 1800s, it presents Kenya as a land of contrasts in geography as well as people. Home to Arabs, Indians, and Europeans as well as various African tribes, Kenya experienced strife throughout its colonial history. Gatheru discusses the viewpoint of the Kenyan people, enumerating the events and attitudes that led to the eruption of violence. Covered in particular are the economic, political, and social policies Britain established toward its colonials. The role of Kenyan reform leaders such as Harry Thuku and Jomo Kenyatta in the country's struggle for independence is also examined. Although Gatheru is quick to establish that Britain's original intentions were admirable, he reveals how the Mau Mau rebellion, which began in 1952, was the ultimate culmination of sixty years of increasingly destructive British policies. The closing chapters of the book deal with the granting of Kenyan independence in 1963, the aftermath of independence, and the plans of Kenya's newborn government for dealing with the issues of labor, agriculture, and land ownership.

A Requiem for Peacebuilding? Jorg Kustermans, Tom Sauer, Barbara Segaert, 2020-12-01 This book assesses the claim that peacebuilding is a moribund international practice. Peacebuilding is a resilient international practice, apt to adjust itself to a changing environment and too important a source of legitimacy for those that wield power.

Churchill and Africa C. Brad Faught, 2023-09-30 This timely book fills a lacuna in the extensive literature on Churchill's life and times. It covers his long relationship with Africa during the most important period in Anglo-African history: from nineteenth-century imperial rule to independence and the emergence of modern Africa. Churchill first went to Africa during the British reconquest of Sudan in 1898 and would spend almost the next sixty years dealing with Africa as soldier, journalist, government minister, and finally prime minister. Churchill's story is one of transition from the height of late Victorian British imperialism to the acceptance of African nationalism in the middle years of the twentieth century. He helped to shape British colonial policy in Africa from the first decade of the twentieth century through the Second World War and colonial Kenya's Mau Mau crisis of the 1950s. Few British leaders were as closely involved with Africa as was Churchill.

Wamagatta, 2016-04-21 Senior Chief Waruhiu wa Kung'u is one of colonial Kenya's most controversial chiefs His name has gone down in history as a traitor who was assassinated because he sold his country to the British colonizers This book is the untold story of the controversial life of Senior Chief Waruhiu who served the colonial government for thirty years He believed his white superiors' authority was God-given and to disobey them was tantamount to disobeying God himself That was why he was considered loyal obedient dependable responsible efficient and a tower of strength Chief Waruhiu's violent death dealt his reputation a devastating blow as it provided his critics with a basis to portray him as a traitor who sold out to the colonizers Although Waruhiu believed that the Africans were not yet ready for self-government and that they could not attain it through violence that did not make him a traitor Other chiefs also believed that and yet were not labeled as traitors However this did lead to him being considered a very pro-government and pro-European chief who was opposed to the aspirations of his people and he as a result deserved to be killed Although it is believed that Waruhiu was killed by Mau Mau there is no evidence to support that claim The white settler community gained a lot from Waruhiu's murder as it paved the way for it to get what it had been demanding for a long time a declaration of a state of emergency and the arrest and detention of African leaders It is very likely that some leaders of the white settlers working together with government officials were probably behind Waruhiu's murder The police the prosecution and the court seemed determined to make the murder charges against the accused suspects stick in spite of glaring discrepancies and
