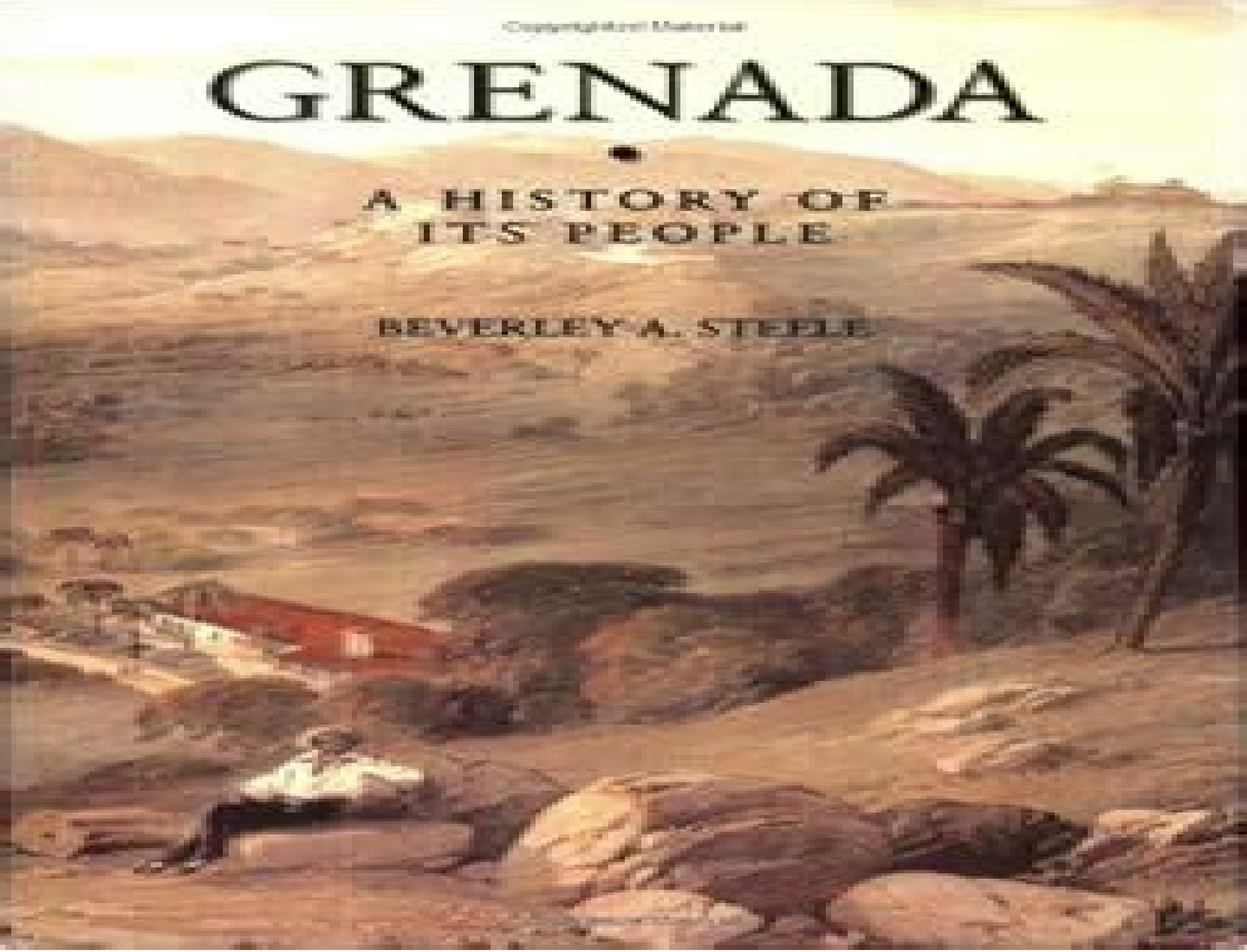

century the Spanish arrived on the island but they never fully colonized it due to fierce resistance from the Caribs The French and British also had interest in the island and established settlements there Grenada gained independence from the British in 1974 and it is now a democratic multi party state that operates under a parliamentary system of government The economy of the country is largely based on agriculture particularly the production of cocoa and nutmeg as well as tourism
