Blood at the Root Jennie Lightweis-Goff, 2011-08-31 In *Blood at the Root* winner of the SUNY Press 2009 Dissertation First Book Prize in African American Studies Jennie Lightweis Goff examines the centrality of lynching to American culture focusing particularly on the ways in which literature popular culture and art have constructed the illusion of secrecy and obsolescence to conceal the memory of violence Including critical study of writers and artists like Ida B Wells Barnett Richard Wright William Faulkner George Schuyler and Kara Walker Lightweis Goff also incorporates her personal experience in the form of a year long travelogue of visits to lynching sites Her research and travel move outside the American South and rural locales to demonstrate the fiction of confining racism to certain areas of the country and the denial of collective responsibility for racial violence Lightweis Goff seeks to implicate societal attitude in the actions of the few and to reveal the legacy of violence that has been obscured by more valiant memories in the public sphere In exploring the ways that spatial and literary texts replace lynching with proclamations of innocence and regret Lightweis Goff argues that racial violence is an incompletely erupted trauma of American life whose very hiddenness links the past to still present practices of segregation and exclusion

Within the rich tradition of Spanish theater lies an unexplored dimension reflecting themes from classical mythology Through close readings of selected plays from early modern and twentieth century Spanish literature with plots or characters derived from the Greco Roman tradition Michael Kidd shows that the concept of desire plays a pivotal role in adapting myth to the stage in each of several historical periods In *Stages of Desire* Kidd offers a new way of looking at the theater in Spain

Reviewing the work of playwrights from Juan del Encina to Luis Riaza he suggests that desire constitutes a central element in a large number of Greco Roman myths and shows how dramatists have exploited this to resituate ancient narratives within their own artistic and ideological horizons Among the works he analyzes are Timoneda s Tragicomedia llamada Filomena Castro s Dido y Eneas and Unamuno s Fedra Kidd explores how seventeenth century playwrights were constrained by the conventions of the newly formed national theater and how in the twentieth century mythological desire was exploited by playwrights engaged in upsetting the melodramatic conventions of the entrenched bourgeois theater He also examines the role of desire both in the demythification of prominent classical heroes during the Franco regime and in the cultural critique of institutionalized discrimination in the current democratic period Stages of Desire is an original and broad ranging study that highlights both change and continuity in Spanish theater By elegantly combining theory literary history and close textual analysis Kidd demonstrates both the resilience of Greco Roman myths and the continuing vitality of the Spanish stage

of the culture of old Vienna Thompson thought there was plenty of room for revising classical analytic thinking in light of later developments Such revisionism she believed need not lose the essential appreciation of the dynamic unconscious within classical analysis However Thompson felt Freud s biological outlook needed to be supplemented by a culturally more sophisticated orientation and she was among those who tried to put Freud s concepts of libido into historical perspective Instead of psychoanalysis having as its objective the release of tensions Thompson proposed that the goal of analysis ought to be the growth of the total personality Her revisionism also meant that the scope of psychoanalytic treatment could be broadened well beyond the neuroses Freud sought to explain Thompson well understood the impact of the social environment on character formation The psychology of women needed to be rethought differences between men and women could be partly explained by the social expectations that traditional Western culture had imposed on them Thompson believed the whole analyst patient relationship needed to be rethought the real personality of the therapist has to be acknowledged and the full human interplay between patient and analyst required examination In the current positivistic therapeutic climate based on technological advances in psychopharmacology the ethical and humanistic dimension may be lost Reflecting on the work of Clara Thompson and the neo Freudian school can remind us of earlier efforts to challenge therapeutic authority and their distinct relevance to our problems today
