The restraints that have been applied are in terms of the quality and methods by which combatants are taken. These questions have also overlapped with ones of compulsion and whether citizens within a country can be compelled to fight without their consent. Accordingly, for the previous 3,000 years, the question has not been whether there should be a limit on the number of soldiers, but rather, who is or is not a lawful combatant. It has rarely been a question of numbers. It has been and remains one of type. The second part of this book is about people typically combatants captured in battle. It is about what happens to their status as prisoners, about the possibilities of torture, assistance if they are wounded, and what happens to their remains should they be killed and their bodies fall into enemy hands.
