internal federal borders were rejected The basis upon which the post secession international borders were accepted in international law involved novel applications of international law principles of self determination of peoples and uti possidetis This book traces the developments of these principles and the historical development of Yugoslavia s internal borders

Pavkovic, 2000-07-24 War World War I created the state of Yugoslavia in 1918 and in a series of wars starting in 1991 Yugoslavia was replaced by several new and smaller states The victors had always presented these wars as wars of national liberation each war was fought for the sacred cause of national liberty The book traces the origins of ideologies appealing to the cause of national liberty and outlines their use in the creation of new states and new political regimes in the Balkans *The Future of NATO Expansion* Zoltan Barany, 2003-07-21 In 1999 three East Central European states Poland Hungary and the Czech Republic gained membership in the North Atlantic Treaty Organization Professor Barany argues that once it began the Alliance should continue the enlargement process Nevertheless he maintains that only states that satisfy NATO s membership criteria should be allowed to join Through an extensive analysis of four countries Bulgaria Romania Slovakia and Slovenia who at the time of the book s original publication in 2003 were NATO aspirants Barany demonstrates that they were in several important respects unprepared for membership and that there was no pressing reason for NATO s haste Barany argues that while NATO should be clear that its doors remain open to qualified candidates the Alliance should hold off further expansion until prospective members will become assets rather than liabilities *Media Discourse and the Yugoslav Conflicts* Pål Kolstø, 2016-04-29 In spite of the growing literature on discourse analysis the relationship of discourse to violent non violent outcomes of conflict is an under researched area This book combines theories on ethnic conflict identity construction and discourse analysis with a comprehensive and inclusive survey of the countries of the former Yugoslavia It presents an understanding of the interrelationship between words and deeds grounded through an extensively close analysis of film television and newspapers samples taken from the period This combination of ground breaking applications of theory with detailed empirical case studies will make *Media Discourse and the Yugoslav Conflicts* of key interest to scholars across a range of social sciences including sociology discourse analysis media conflict and peace studies as well as those concerned with ethno-political conflict *Faces on the Ballot* Alan Renwick, Jean-Benoit Pilet, 2016-02-05 One of the key shifts in contemporary politics is the trend towards greater personalization Collective actors such as political parties are losing relevance Citizens are slowly dealigning from these actors and individual politicians are therefore growing in importance in elections in government within parties and in media reporting of politics A crucial question concerns how this new pattern could be restructuring politics over the long run notably whether the personalization of politics is changing the institutional architecture of contemporary democracies The authors show that the trend towards personalization is indeed changing core democratic institutions Studying the evolution of electoral systems in thirty one European democracies since 1945 they demonstrate that since the 1990s there has been a

shift towards more personalized electoral systems Electoral systems in most European countries now allow voters to express preferences for candidates not just for political parties And the weight of these voters preferences in the allocation of seats has been increased in numerous countries They examine the factors that appear to be driving this evolution finding that the personalization of electoral systems is associated with the growing gap between citizens and politics Politicians and legislators appear to perceive the personalization of electoral systems as a way to address the democratic malaise and to restore trust in politics by reducing the role of political parties in elections The book also shows however that whether these reforms have had any success in achieving their aims is far less clear

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Recognition in International Law Stefan Talmon, 2021-10-18 The bibliography lists the literature and State practice on the question of recognition in international law for the last two hundred years It contains books and articles ie contributions to journals and other collected works such as *Festschriften* and *Encyclopaedias* as well as published and unpublished theses pamphlets compilations of diplomatic documents and case notes As many of the monographs on recognition in international law will not be available in all libraries book reviews have been included in the bibliography in order to enable the user to decide whether it may be advisable to order a certain work by inter library loan Its 4 500 entries are arranged systematically according to subject categories in fourteen main sections Each main section is further subdivided with ever increasing specificity into sub sections on codification codification attempts general studies studies of certain recognition questions and studies of specific recognition cases The bibliography employs a broad meaning of recognition It is not restricted to the question of status of an authority or entity in international law but encompasses also the question of relations with it As many of the recognition cases must be considered and can only be understood against their historic political and sometimes even economic background the bibliography includes not only purely legal treaties but also publications of a primarily historical political or economic content which incidentally deal with aspects of recognition in international law This is reflected by the titles of the 730 journals from more than 50 countries in 20 different languages which have been used to compile the bibliography The bibliography contains both an author and a comprehensive subject index to enable users to locate works of a particular writer or a specific problem

The Politics of Europeanization and Post-Socialist Transformations N. Lindstrom, 2014-12-12 This study examines conflicts arising from the dual processes of Europeanization and post socialist transformations from gaining independence in 1991 to facing the current economic crisis
